Apple Graphics Source 3.0

Apple Graphics Source (AGS) includes over 2,000 graphics of Apple's products. Using the AGS stacks, you can find, copy, or print any of the original graphic files.

Getting started

To get started, open one of the AGS stacks. After you click Open on the first card of the stack, the first graphic card appears. Each graphic card refers to one graphic file. On the left side of the card is a small representation of the graphic. The right side of the card has text that describes the graphic.

To find specific graphics

To find specific graphics, click the Find button, then select a field to search by and click OK. In the dialog box that follows, select the term to search for and click OK.

To find graphics using more than one criterion

To find graphics using more than one criterion, click the Find button and select File Format, Keyword, or Book from the dialog box. In the dialog box that follows, select a term to search for, then hold down the Command key to select more terms. When you're ready to see all of the cards with all of the selected terms, click OK.

To search backwards through the stack

When searching, the stack normally progresses forward through the stack. To search backwards through the stack, click the Find button and select File Format, Keyword, or Book from the dialog box. Next, select the term or term(s) you want to find. When you click OK, press the Option key to search backwards through the stack.

To open the graphic of the current card

To open in a new window the graphic file of the current card, click Open Graphic.

To copy all or part of the graphic

To copy the graphic, first click Open Graphic to open the file. Choose Select All from the Edit menu to select the entire graphic, or drag the crosshair across the part of the graphic you want to copy (when the cursor is in the graphic's window, it becomes a crosshair). To copy the selection, choose Copy from the Edit menu.

To print all or part of the graphic

To print the entire graphic, click Open Graphic to open the file, then choose Print from the Graphic menu.

To print a selection of the graphic, click Open Graphic to open the file. Drag the crosshair across the part of the graphic you want to print (when the cursor is in the graphic's window, it becomes a crosshair). To print the selection, choose Print Selection from the Graphic menu.

To go to another Graphics Source stack

To go to a different Graphics Source stack, click one the following buttons: Hardware, Networks, or Technical.

To get help online

To get help while using the stack, click Help. Click on button or fields to find out what they do. To close Help, click the Help button again or click the Help panel's close box.

To quit Apple Graphics Source

To quit Apple Graphics Source and leave HyperCard, click Quit.
