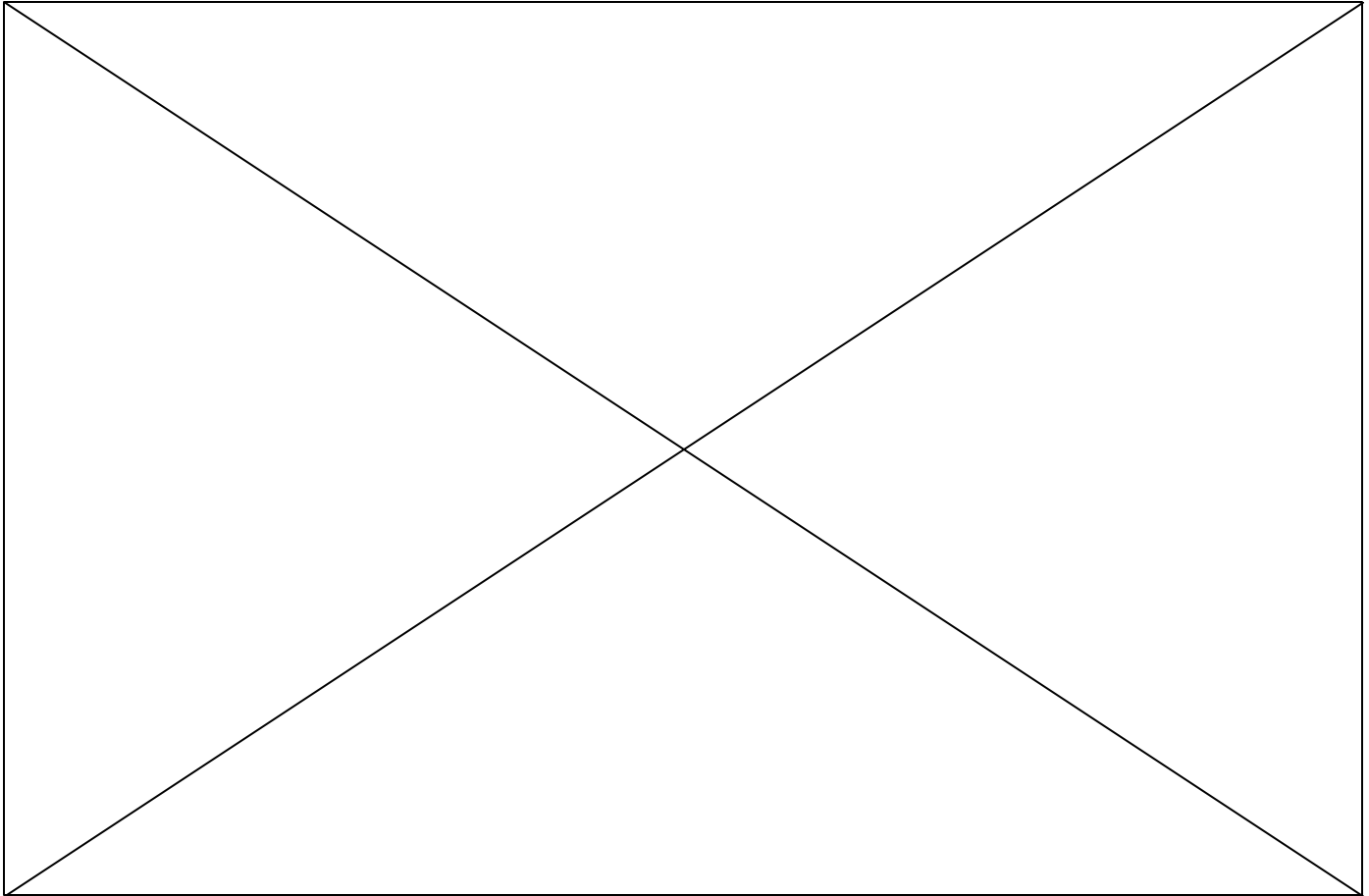


# Macintosh Classic 1MB Memory Expansion Card



## Overview

---

The Apple® Macintosh® Classic® 1MB Memory Expansion Card lets you expand a Macintosh Classic personal computer that has one megabyte of dynamic random-access memory (DRAM) to a system with two megabytes of DRAM. Single In-line Memory Module (SIMM) sockets on the card let you add up to two more megabytes of DRAM—for a total of up to four megabytes.

With more system memory in your Macintosh Classic, you can work on large documents; run advanced Macintosh application programs—those with sophisticated graphic images and sound files, for instance; and work with more applications simultaneously under the MultiFinder® operating system.
