The Apple® StyleWriter® printer makes professional-quality printing of text and graphics more affordable than ever for anyone who uses a Macintosh® personal computer.

Designed for individual use, the StyleWriter printer is an excellent choice for people who want laser-quality printed results for personal or business correspondence or for general purpose use. The ideal companion for the Macintosh Classic,® Macintosh LC, and Macintosh IIsx personal computer, the StyleWriter printer works with any Macintosh. It offers a convenient—and very quiet—personal printing alternative for people who share a networked Apple LaserWriter® printer.

With its sleek design and small footprint, the StyleWriter printer fits conveniently in even the smallest spaces and can be put to work immediately. There's no need to purchase a cable, interface card, or additional printer memory. The StyleWriter printer comes with a detachable sheet feeder that automatically and accurately feeds up to 50 sheets of paper into the printer. You can also use the printer without the sheet feeder—front and rear manual feed options simplify the printing of single sheets of letterheads, envelopes, labels, or transparencies for overhead projection.

Another advantage of the StyleWriter printer is that it comes with four TrueType type families: Times,® Helvetica,® Courier, and Symbol. TrueType, Apple's advanced font technology, allows you to print high-quality text in any size you like and makes the text on your screen smoother and more legible. In addition to the TrueType fonts that come with the StyleWriter printer, additional TrueType fonts that are available from other suppliers, including text and headline fonts, symbol fonts for special purposes, and novelty fonts for decoration, are compatible.

Product Details

How the StyleWriter printer works
The StyleWriter printer ensures excellent printed results every time, because its design incorporates an easy-to-use, replaceable print cartridge to create letters or images on a page. When you give the Print command on your Macintosh, the computer sends a dot-by-dot "guide," or bitmap, for each page to the printer.

The internal computer in the StyleWriter printer reconstructs this bitmap by matching the ink cartridge nozzles with the map. The printer then forms a very fine dot pattern—360 dots per inch or 130,000 dots per square inch—to produce a page of text and graphics at a rate of about one-half page per minute.

TrueType
When printing, the StyleWriter printer uses TrueType, Apple's advanced font technology that provides high-quality text on all Macintosh computers and printers. TrueType makes it possible for you to print text in any size you want, from tiny footnotes to headlines. TrueType also makes the text on your screen smoother and more legible and ensures that the screen text closely matches the printed results.

System Requirements

The StyleWriter printer works with any member of the Macintosh family of personal computers that uses system software version 6.0.7 or later and a minimum of 1 megabyte of RAM.
