## A BRIEF HISTORY OF PUBLISHING

400 First known inked impressions on paper.

1440 Johann Gutenberg develops the movable type press in Germany, cutting letters from an alloy of lead, tin, and antimony.

1449 Aldus Manutius is born in Padua.

1487 The Aldine Press is founded in Venice.

1501 The Aldine Press publishes Dante's Divine Comedy.

1515 Aldus Manutius dies.

1757 In England, William Baskerville publishes Virgil's Aeneid and Eclogues, using woven paper and a slender typeface.

1814 The first steam-powered, high-speed press is built to print the London Times.

1866 The first rotary press is brought into production, printing both sides of a continuous web of paper.

1884 Ottmar Mergenthaler invents the Linotype.
