

If you have WordPerfect for the Macintosh, you can convert this WordPerfect/PC 5.0 using the utility included on your disks. Notice the formatting from the PC document:

**Bold**, underline, *italic*, ~~strikeout~~, even <sup>super</sup>script and <sub>sub</sub>script text remain after conversion.

Note that if you have MacWrite II, with its XTND technology, you can open this file and it will be recognized and converted automatically. AccessPC is the natural complement to XTND-based applications, because XTND can recognize many PC file formats and AccessPC lets you read the files directly from the PC disks.
