This is a template for a newsletter. The newsletter title is created using a header. The main body of the newsletter is formatted in three columns. You can choose to have left and right pages and headers and footers by choosing left and right pages from the Page Format dialog. The number of columns can be changed in the Page Format dialog as well.

Bars separating the header from the main body were created in MacDraw II and then inserted into the template to add emphasis. If you are using a Macintosh with a color monitor or have a color printer you may want to use color graphics in your newsletter.
