Power Macintosh G3 with FireWire

Apple's adoption of FireWire as a standard technology on the Power Macintosh G3 marks the first time that both video and computer hardware manufacturers have embraced the same technology. This means that Mac users can instantly connect FireWire-compatible DV cameras and tape decks directly to their computer. Then they can immediately capture high-quality digital video, and edit and enhance those images before sending them back to tape at pristine resolution.

QuickTime

Apple's QuickTime software is a complete technology for handling video, sound, animation, graphics, text, music, and even 360-degree virtual reality (VR) scenes. Now, with the introduction of QuickTime 4, video producers also have the ability to stream digital video over the web, delivering synchronized audio and video of remarkable clarity and quality. QuickTime allows you to use digital video footage in many different applications. And when you're ready for output, QuickTime easily exports files to any medium, including videotape, CD-ROM, and the World Wide Web.

Final Cut Pro

Apple's new Final Cut Pro software gives you all you need to create top-notch video productions. You get fast, interactive editing tools; high-speed previews and rendering; and lots of easy-to-use, eye-catching special effects. Final Cut Pro lets you drag-and-drop clips throughout most of the major edit functions. You can even add transitions and view effects before you go to tape. Final Cut Pro is a complete post-production studio-in-a-box.
