


The Macintosh for Graphic Design

and Illustration What does it take to survive graphic designers and publishing

in today's deadline-driven environments? Just ask the professionals who work on Power Macintosh G3 computers. They'll likely tell you "standards, simplicity, color, and automation." What they probably won't give you is a long explanation. That's because busy people don't talk a lot about Macintosh computers. They simply use them.



Industry standard

For years now, skilled freelance artists, digital illustrators, and font designers have used Macintosh systems to create their artwork. In addition to these professionals, the vast majority of prepress houses and service bureaus have also standardized on Macintosh computers. To ensure compatibility with this large industry, creative professionals use the same system and tools that their design and illustration peers rely on.

Intelligent operating system

The Mac OS maintains its superiority by simplifying file sharing, reading documents from other platforms, writing high-quality PostScript, and searching drives or the Internet at a sophisticated level using Sherlock. Macintosh still provides the best management of fonts and graphics. Fonts are in one location, and when you specify an Adobe Type 1 font on the Macintosh, you know the operating system will not confuse you with hidden TrueType versions that might not work at the service bureau.

ColorSync color control

Apple's ColorSync is a sophisticated color management technology that ensures consistent color throughout the creative process. With ColorSync, displays are precisely calibrated and images can be "soft-proofed" at significant savings to clients and vendors. ColorSync is already at work in production tools such as Photoshop and QuarkXPress. And when you open stock photos from PhotoDisc or Corbis, the color you see is consistent because many of these images include embedded profiles used by Apple's ColorSync.

AppleScript automation

AppleScript is a powerful technology built into the Mac OS that automates many illustration and publishing tasks. Time-consuming or repetitive tasks, such as backing up files or optimizing graphics, can be easily performed while you're at lunch or after your workday is over. AppleScript works in conjunction with many of today's most popular programs, including Adobe Photoshop, QuarkXPress, Multi-Ad Creator2, and Canto Cumulus.
