

## Welcome to MultiView 2000

MultiView 2000 is 32-bit Terminal Emulation for Windows® 95 and Windows NT®. Unique terminal emulation which can connect UNIX applications to the Internet and Intranet.

The full MultiView 2000 suite comprises of the following:

### MultiView 2000 Components

- File Transfer** a utility which allows you to see all files and folders on your computer. It also displays any mapped network drives and remote systems that are currently available.
- Terminal Emulation** allows you to launch remote UNIX applications from your Windows PC and simultaneously switch freely between local and remote applications.
- Printing** enables print requests on a local PC to be redirected to a remote system printer or print requests on a remote system to be redirected to a printer connected to a local PC or network.
- MultiPing** enables you to test that a remote system is available and whether a specified service on the system is acknowledging requests.

### MultiView 2000 Help

Help is obtainable for each component from the relevant application's help menu. A combined help of all the installed components is also available from the MultiView 2000 submenu in the Programs menu. This combined help may include a technical reference for the advanced user with specific details on the more technical aspects of the product.

Help on each component includes an explanation, a quick guide to getting started on the application, a comprehensive list of how to carryout various tasks and if applicable, how the component interacts with other parts of the product.

Many of the dialogs include context sensitive help to provide detailed help on specific parts of each application. Refer to [Windows® 95 Help](#) for details on how to use context sensitive help.
