Modem

Here you can choose all necessary settings for your modem, such as: interface type, pulse/tone mode and of course the phone number.

The **General View** of the whole map. To **Go To The Chosen Area** just click on the desired part of the Map.

Setting The Printer

Here you can set all the parameters of the printer you have installed in your system. Right after opening the Printer Settings window you can:

1. Determine the **size of the printout**:
 - all pages
 - only the marked fragment
 - pages from...to...
2. Determine the **resolution of the picture** - in dots per inch (dpi) - the greater the number the higher the quality - its limited by the possibilities of your printer.
3. Determine the **number of the copies** you wish to obtain.

By choosing the **PROPERTIES** icon you can set the following parameters:

1. **Choice Of The Printer**:
 - set the default printer.
 - other (in case there is more than one printer)
2. **Orientation** : horizontal or vertical
3. **Paper** :
 - size - A4, A5, etc.
 - feeding: automatic or manual

Prints the fragment of the Map as seen on the screen.

Turns on or off the scale adjusting mode. In order to adjust the scale use the left mouse button to **zoom in** and the right one to **zoom out**.
The scale is shown in the lower panel of the screen.

An additional **control panel** to help you work with the program. Point the icon with a cursor to see the **tag** describing its function. To **use the desired function** click on the left mouse button.

A handy **note pad** with basic options of a text editor.

A **Calendar** that shows todays date.

Language change - takes you back to the main menu where you can choose the language.

Quits the program and **goes back** to Windows.

SEARCH FOR...

By using this menu you can easily find not only the street you desire but also most of the city institutions: offices, hospitals, museums, theatres, cinemas, ambulance service, Police. You will also find a list of leisure places and important phone numbers.

Streets

You can find every street that is on the City Map.

To find the street:

- **Type** in the upper window the name of the street. While typing you'll see names of the streets that begin with letters you're typing in.
- When the desired name appears, **confirm your choice** by clicking on **CHOOSE** or hitting **ENTER**
- **A blinking red and blue arrow** will show you where the street you have picked, is located.
- To make the **arrow disappear** just click on it with the left mouse button.

Offices, Culture, Health, Important Phone Numbers, Accommodation, Transportation.

To choose the desired institution:

- Look at the list - you'll see the **name, address and the phone number** of various institutions.
- **Browse** through the list using your mouse or cursor keys on the keyboard.
- Click on **DIAL** to **connect** with the chosen **phone number**.
- Click on **DISCONNECT** to **end the connection**.
- Click on **SEARCH** to see the location of the chosen object on the Map. A **blinking red and blue arrow** will point the object. To make the **arrow disappear** click on it with the left mouse button.

METROPOLITAN AREA

Here you will find several maps of the Area of Cracow

The icons located in the upper left corner of the screen are used to zoom in, zoom out, set the size of the scale and to return to the original Map.

In case of troubles click on:



You can move across the map using the arrows situated in the right and lower margins of the screen.

Exit and go back to the main Map.

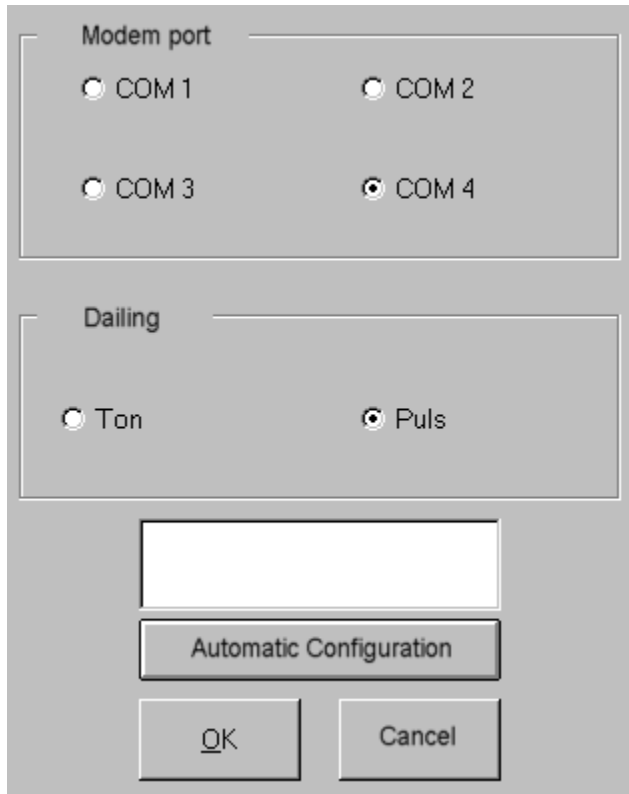

How To Change The Modem Settings

That's the modem configuration panel. Click on the chosen icon to learn how it works.

Choose the **port** used by the modem:
COM1, COM2, COM3 or COM4.

Automatic configuration of the modem.

Exit the modem configuration **without saving** the changes.

Pulse/tone dialling.

Type a **prefix** here if you are using an internal telephone exchange or you are dialling a number with an area code. Use the comma (,) for a 1 sec. delay before dialling the next number, e.g. typing 0,,42 makes the system wait 3 secs. between dialling 0 and 42.

Confirmation of the modem configuration.

How To Watch The Videos?



Click on the chosen icon to learn how it works.

In this place **films are showed.**

Start the film.

End the film.

Pause/Restart.

Watch **all movies** one after another.

Print the frame.

Language change.

End film, back to Map.

Choose the film you want to see.

This strip shows you **how far** it is **to the end** of the film.

An icon controlling the **speed** of the film projection.

How To View The Photos?

To view the photos you will use the viewer program. Its controls are located on the right side of the screen.

- **NEXT** - shows the **next photo** of the series.
- **PREVIOUS** - shows the **previous photo** of the series.
- **START/STOP** - lets you watch the photos one after another.
- **MAP - shows on the Map** the location of the object you see on the photograph. To make the **arrow disappear** click on it with the left mouse button.
- **PRINT** - prints the photo you are currently watching.
- **DESCRIPTION** - shows the short comments on the photo.
- **ABOUT** - shows the detail comments on the photo.

To enlarge the photograph simply click on it. The control panels will disappear. One more click will bring them back.

You can **move across the Map** by:

- **using cursor keys** on your keyboard,
- **using your mouse and the scrolls** which are located on the lower and right margins of the screen.

The icon in the lower right corner of the screen brings you to the central point of the Map.

In the lower part of the screen the present time, date and the scale of the map and of the object are displayed.

Using The Control Panel

The reference control panel lets you use some basic functions of the program and change all the settings related with the program. It makes the work with the program much easier.
