#### Application Manager

Application Manager allows you to select applications for Uninstalling, Moving, Transporting, or Archiving.

You can select the application by choosing its shortcut under Start Menu, Desktop, or WinDelete Installations. You can also Browse to its executable file.

### <WD97DOCKINGDATA:Internet Manager Description>



#### Internet Manager

Internet Manager locates the following types of files for Uninstalling, Moving, Transporting, or Archiving:

- Netscape Navigator Cache - temporary files which were downloaded from the Internet using Netscape Navigator.
- Windows Internet Cache - temporary files which were downloaded from the Internet using the Microsoft Internet Explorer v3.0 (and later).

- Microsoft Internet Explorer Cache - temporary files which were downloaded from the Internet using Microsoft Internet Explorer v1.0.
- Internet DownLoads - Downloads which were logged by the WinDelete Agent.
- Netscape Navigator Plug-Ins - Browsing enhancements which are designed for Netscape Navigator.
- ActiveX Controls - Browsing enhancements which are designed for Microsoft Internet Explorer.

### <WD97DOCKINGDATA:Duplicate Finder Description>



#### **Duplicate Finder**

Duplicate Finder allows you to find files that are duplicated on your system.

### <WD97DOCKINGDATA:Debris Finder Description>



#### **Debris Finder**

Debris Finder will search for extraneous files, including Invalid Shortcuts, Orphan DLLs, Unused Files, Empty Files (Zero Bytes), Backup and Temporary files, and \*.chk files created by ScanDisk.

### <WD97DOCKINGDATA:Graph Viewer Description>



#### **Chart Viewer**

Chart Viewer displays histograms of files on your harddrive(s). It will display charts of File Types, File Usage, and Usage Frequency.

### <WD97DOCKINGDATA:CleanUp Wizard Description>



#### **CleanUp Wizard**

Cleanup Wizard will guide you through most of the cleanup procedures in WinDelete 97.

#### **WinDelete Options**

WinDelete Options allows you to modify WinDelete 97's settings.

#### **WinDelete Agent Options**
