

How safe is this program ?

Hackman is extremely safe (even the preview editions from build 109 and above) as long as you are **completely aware** of what you are doing.

Here is a [tip](#): take always a backup of the file that you intend to interfere with. To accomplish this you could use the Windows Explorer or from Files | Backup generate a backup copy of your selected file.

There was no report from beta testers for damage caused by the program itself.

Anyway, a unlimited undo task list is tightly attached to our kernel, so that you can undo **any** change that you've made to the source file.
