If you click on the rightmost button, the one with the question mark, a windows menu will pop up. Click on the menu choice you want. Click anywhere else on the screen to close the menu.

Positions. The first six choices locate the launcher bar in the position most convenient for you. The position will be stored when you exit, so the launcher bar will load in that position the next time you run the program.

Each of the six choices locates the bar in the position specified: Upper Left, Upper Center, Upper Right, Lower Left, Lower Center, and Lower Right.

Help Boxes. As you pass the mouse pointer over each button on the launcher bar, a little box pops up to tell you what the button does. The two menu choices turn this feature **on** and **off.**

Help. Click on this choice and you will get these instructions on how to use the launcher bar. You can also get these instructions by pressing the **F1** key.

How to Use this Help File

This help file works like any other Windows® Help file.

Buttons. Click on the buttons (or press the underlined letter key) for various helps. The "Contents" button takes you to the opening window of the help file. The "Back" button takes you to the window you were reading previous to the current help window. The "Search" button will help you find particular topics to find help about. The "History" button shows you the various help windows you have read since you called up the help file. The Arrow buttons, or Browse buttons, take you to the next (>>) or previous (<<) window.

Menu Line. Click on "File" (or press Alt-F) to Copy or Print the current window or to **Exit** this Help File. The "Open" choice will start another—file or program.

Click on "Edit" to add your own comments to a help file or copy the current window to the Windows® Clipboard. Click on the picture of a small paper clip to make the comment appear.

Click on "Bookmark" to mark the window you are reading so you can find it quickly next time, or to go to that mark you made.

Click on "Help" (or press Alt- H) for more information on how to use the Help file. The "Always on Top" option here is best left checked. Click to un-check, and other programs (including the launcher bar) may show through the help file. If you switch to another Help file and the launcher bar shows through, click on the "Always on Top" option. The "About" option gives you some information about this help file.

Underlining. Click on any underlined portion to go to more information on that subject.
