## Loaded Modules Tab

The **Loaded Modules** tab shows all the executable modules on your workstation that are loaded. To see additional information about a module, choose the module name and then choose **Details**.

You can also double-click the module name to see additional information about it.

## **NWD Tab**

The **NWD** tab displays information that is typically found in an **About** window.

## Novell Tab

The **Novell** tab shows the executable modules on your workstation that are both loaded and from Novell\*. To see additional information about a module, choose the module name and then choose **Details**.

You can also double-click the module name to see additional information about it.

## Novell Windows Diagnostics (NWD)

Use the Novell\* Windows\*\* Diagnostics (NWD) tool to examine the executable modules that are loaded. If a workstation user is experiencing a baffling problem, use NWD to make sure that the latest program is used and that a duplicate (and probably obsolete) program is not being loaded by mistake.

Choose **NWD** for information about the NWD tool.

Choose **Novell** for information about Novell executable modules that are loaded.

Choose **Loaded Modules** for information about all executable modules that are loaded.

Choose **Save/Print** to print the information about the executable modules that are loaded.

Choose **Exit** when finished using the NWD tool.

For information about the order in which Windows searches for an executable file, see Search Order.

## **Save / Print Tab**

Use the **Save/Print** tab to save or print the information about loaded executable modules. Choose **All Loaded Modules** or **Only Novell\* Modules**, and then choose **Clipboard, Save to File**, or **Print**.

All the available information about each loaded module is saved or printed.

## Search Order

Windows\*\* searches for executable modules in the following places and in the following order:

1. The current directory.
2. The Windows directory (typically, C:\WINDOWS).
3. The Windows system directory (typically, C:\WINDOWS\SYSTEM).
4. The directory containing the executable file for the current task.
5. The directories listed by the PATH environment variable.
6. The directories mapped to network drives.
