Using the TNVTPlus Script Wizard?

Using the TNVTPlus Script Wizard you have set up script options, including automatic login.

The Wizard displays the prompt from the network host. You can continue to enter new commands to the prompt or end the current script using the <u>response list</u>.

Note

Click the Options button to:

- Add an additional host prompt string
- Change the host timeout originally specified in the TNVTPlus Script Wizard

When you add an additional host prompt string, the script responds to the original host prompt and the new prompt.

Prompt Response	Action
Username	Sends username to network host.
Password	Sends password to network host. Password prompt dialog displays if password was not previously entered.
<enter key=""></enter>	Sends Enter key to host (action defined by emulator option).
Ignore	Ignores the current prompt and continues to scan data from the network host until a prompt response is recognized.
Custom	Sends the command you enter.
End Script	Stops the script and prompts for a script filename.
End Script and Telnet	Stops the script, prompts for a script filename, and closes the TNVTPlus application.
