Delete...:

Displays the Delete dialog box from which you may delete the selected Zip files or files from within a Zip archive.

Find Files may only be used when the cursor is in the Tree / File Panel of a drive view. It permits you to search the contents of the active drive window for a set of files.

Tree / File Views

Tree Views display all the directories on your disk in a hierarchical format.

Your directories and their contents are displayed with subdirectories indented and below their parent directory.

You may select multiple directories for Zipping in one operation.

Extract archive files to a specific directory by dragging files from a <u>Zip List</u> or <u>Zip View</u> and dropping them on the desired directory.

File Views display all the directories on your disk in a linear format.

Your directories and their contents are displayed vertically. The directory name appears as a grey header followed by all the files in that directory. Immediately following the last file in a directory is the grey header for the next directory or subdirectory, then its files and so on.

When you toggle into the File View mode the current directory appears at the very top of the window, and is indicated with a red flag at the left end of the directory name.

Scrolling in the file view allows you to view all the files on the disk.

Extract archive files to a specific directory by dragging files from a <u>Zip List</u> or <u>Zip View</u> and dropping them on the desired directory.

Hint: To quickly **toggle between Tree and File** view click the toggle button at the top of the Tree / File panel or right click on a directory tree or file panel.

Hint: To quickly move between directories while in the file view, hold the control key while paging. This will automatically bring the next directory to the top of the window.

Zip Lists

The <u>Zip List</u> panel shows all the Zip archive files on the associated disk.

Use the Zip List to select file(s) to be opened in a <u>Zip View</u> window.

Zip Views

The <u>Zip View</u> windows show the files contained within a Zip Archive file.

The file properties available in this window include the filename its original date/time and the files original and packed size.

Dragging Files **From** the Zip View

Extract files from archives by dragging a selection of files from a Zip View and dropping it on a directory in the <u>Tree/File</u> panel or a <u>drive button</u> in the Drive Bar or the <u>UnZip tool</u> in the Tool Bar.

Dropping Files on the Zip View

Add files to an existing archive by dragging files from a Tree / File panel and dropping the selection on the Zip View window that you want to add them to.

The Tool Bar

- Zip a file selection from a <u>Tree</u> / <u>File</u> panel by dropping it on the <u>Zip button</u>. or Click the Zip button to Zip the file selection.
- **UnZip** a file selection in a <u>Zip List</u> or <u>Zip View</u> by dropping it on the <u>UnZip button</u>. or Click the UnZip button to UnZip the file selection.

- note: The Zip archives themselves are deleted in this case.

Quit Zip Pro by clicking the Exit button.

The Drive Bar

Use the Drive Bar to open Drive View windows.

Each Drive View window contains the contents of a specific drive.

Dropping Files **on** a <u>Drive Button</u>

Create a new archive on a specific drive by dragging files from a <u>Tree</u> / <u>File</u> panel and dropping the selection on a Drive button.

Add files to an existing archive on a specific drive by dragging files from a Tree / File panel and dropping the selection on a Drive button.

Extract files to a specific drive by dragging files from a <u>Zip List</u> or <u>Zip View</u> and dropping the selection on a Drive button.

Note: In all these cases you will be prompted to select a target directory (and a Zip name when creating or adding files) on the selected drive.

The Status Bar

The Status Bar provides hints on menu options.

Using the Mouse for Navigation

- The right mouse button is used for Navigation.
- Drive View: <u>Tree View</u> Click the right button on a directory to switch to File View for that directory.
- Drive View: <u>File View</u> Click the right button anywhere within the window to switch back to Tree View. scrolling note: Hold the control key while paging to flip between directories.
- Drive View: <u>Archive List:</u> Click the right button on any Zip file to open a window containing that archive.
- Zip View Clicking the right button has no function at this time.

Using the Keyboard for Navigation

- Use the cursor (arrow) keys to scroll within a window. note: Hold the control key while paging to flip between directories.
- Use **Tab** to toggle between the <u>File/Tree</u> views.
- Use **Shift+Tab** to switch between the <u>Drive Panel</u> and the <u>Zip List Panel</u>.
- Use **Ctrl+Tab** to move between windows.
- Use Alt+Tab to move between applications.

Using the Mouse for Selection

The left button is used for selecting.

In any Zip Pro window you may use the following procedures to select files.

Click the left button and drag to select a set of files or directories.

- To add files to an existing selection:

 - press and hold the Ctrl key.
 then Click the left button and drag.
- To add a block of files from the last selection point:
 - press and hold the Shift key.
 - then Click the left button and drag.



The <u>drag bubble</u> appears to represent your selection.

Hint: To clear a selection click the right mouse button on the drag bubble or press Escape!

Note: The large Drag Bubble is sensitive the velocity of the mouse. Therefore if you want to use the large Drag Bubble to drag your selection do not move the mouse after making a selection.

Using the Keyboard for Selection

Press and hold the SHIFT key while scrolling to select/deselect a group of files/directories.

• Or press the SPACE BAR to select/deselect individual files/directories.



The small <u>drag bubble</u> appears to represent your selection.

Hint: To clear a selection click the right mouse button on the drag bubble or press Escape!

What is a Drag Bubble



Small Drag Bubble

- The Drag Bubble is used to represent the selection in a window.
- Use the Drag Bubble to drag a file selection.
- When you scroll a window the Drag Bubble disappears while you scroll but returns when you stop.

Therefore you may always access the selection in a window even if none of the selected files/directories appear on the screen.

Þ The Drag Bubble appears as a result of making a selection in a window.

The large Drag Bubble will appear if you don't move the mouse after making a selection, thereby allowing you to quickly grab the bubble.

Þ The large Drag Bubble will disappear if you move away from it.

Þ The small Drag Bubble will appear when the large Drag Bubble disappears or if you move after making a selection.

The small Drag Bubble will always stay in the upper corner of its associated window.

The small Drag Bubble is hidden while you scroll a window. ▶

Right clicking on a Drag Bubble will pop it and clear its selection.

- Selecting the add method (Add , Update , Freshen).
- You may use the tool bar, the mouse or the main menu to add to a Zip archive.

Adding files if the target drive is open

- First select the files that you wish to add to the Zip.
- Scroll the <u>Zip List</u> panel so that the target archive file is visible.
- Grab the drag bubble from the <u>Tree</u> / <u>File</u> panel and drop it on the archive in the Zip List.

Adding files If the target drive is not open

- First select the files that you wish to add to the Zip.
- Grab the drag bubble and drop it on the <u>target drive</u> in the Drive Bar.

- or Grab the drag bubble and drop it on <u>Zip button.</u>
- Use the Archive Name dialog to select the Zip archive to which you wish to add the files.

Adding files if the Zip (Archive) is open

- Drop the selection on a directory in a <u>Tree</u> / <u>File</u> panel.
- or Drop the selection on a <u>Drive button.</u>
- or Drop the selection on or click the <u>UnZip button</u>.
- or use the File Menu 'UnZip Files...' item.

Note: You can only UnZip one Zip file at a time using this process. If you select more than one file from the Zip List, only the first in the selection will be expanded.

Expanding Selected Files from within an Archive

How to Delete Files from an Archive

Selecting Files



Using the Mouse:

The left button is used for selecting.

In any Zip Pro window you may use the following procedures to select files:

- Click the left button and drag to select a set of files or directories.
- To add files to an existing selection:
 - press and hold the Ctrl key.
 - then Click the left button and drag.
- To add a block of files from the last selection point:

 - press and hold the Shift key.then Click the left button and drag.



The <u>drag bubble</u> appears to represent your selection.

Using the keyboard:

Hint: Click the right mouse button on a drag bubble or press Escape to clear a selection!

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Using the Keyboard:

- Press and hold the SHIFT key while scrolling to select/deselect a group of files/directories.
- Or press the SPACE BAR to select/deselect individual files/directories.

The <u>drag bubble</u> appears to represent your selection.

Using the Drag Bubble:

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- The Drag Bubble appears after you make a new selection in a window.
- The Bubble represents all the files/directories selected in that window only.
- Use the Left button to Drag & Drop the selection represented by the drag bubble.
- Right click on a drag bubble to pop it and clear its file selection.
- Pressing Esc (Escape) will pop it and clear its file selection.

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If you move the mouse away from the large drag bubble this smaller version will appear in the upper right corner of the window so you may access the selection - even if all selected files are scrolled off screen.

Both the small and the large drag bubble work in the same manner.

Drag & Drop Features

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Note: Valid drop targets will also have a red border when you move over them.

Depending on the window from which you are moving files you may drop on many different window areas , including: Toolbar buttons, Drive buttons, directories in Drive view, Archive files in the Zip List or Archive windows.

Note: This version of Zip Pro does not support dropping outside the Zip Pro window.

From the Tree / File Panel or from a Zip window...

Zip Progress - Dialog Help

Function: The archive operation to be performed.

Add to Zip: All selected files are added to the zip.

Freshen Zip: Only selected files that have been modified more recently than the copies in the archive are added.

Update Zip: Only selected files that have been modified more recently than the copies in the archive or files which are not currently in the archive are added.

Note: For all these operations existing files with the same name are overwritten.

List Box: Lists the files as they are added to the archive.

Include Directory Information: If selected will include the path information with the files in the archive.

Zip Name: The name of the target archive file.

Selected: Number of files, directories and bytes to be processed.

Note: Actual processed figures may differ for **freshen** or **update** operations if some file(s) do not need to be processed.

Processing/Percent: Shows the number of the file being processed along with the percentage of that file that has been compressed.

Function: The extraction operation to be performed.

note: the source Zip archive is indicated in the dialog title.

Copy from Zip: All selected archive files are copied to the selected destination directory from the Zip archive.

Freshen from Zip: Only selected archive files that have been modified more recently than the copies in the destination drive are copied.

Update from Zip: Only selected archive files that have been modified more recently than the copies in the destination or files which are not currently in the destination are copied.

Note: For all these operations existing files with the same name are overwritten.

List Box: Lists the files as they are copied to the destination.

Use Directory Information: If selected will reconstruct the path of the original file starting at the selected destination path.

Destination: The path that will be used as the target of the extraction operation.

Selected: Number of files and bytes to be extracted.

Note: Actual processed figures may differ for **freshen** or **update** operations if some file(s) do not need to be processed.

Processing/Percent: Shows the number of the file being processed along with the percentage of that file that has been compressed.

Zip Options - Dialog Help

- Compression:
- Compression options:

Low:No compression - packing only.Medium:Best trade off between speed and size.High:Maximum compression - slowest.

Include Directory Names: Specifies the default value for directory inclusion during Zip and UnZip operations.

Convert LF to CRLF: Specifies the default for Zip and UnZip operations.

Zip: Use this if you are compressing a file that was created on a MAC or UNIX machine and your target is a DOS machine.

UnZip: Use this if the archive was created on a UNIX or MAC machine. On a DOS machine the extracted file will appear without any line breaks and may cause errors when attempting to load them into an editor.

Note: Use this option only if needed and only on text files as it will corrupt binary files.

Disk Spanning:

Allow file splitting: Turn this option off only if you want to ensure that files archived to removable media will not be split. You may want to disable this because archives that are created on **removable** media with this option set cannot be updated.

Low density disks: Used this options to force Zip Pro to format removable media with the lowest density for the drive. If no Pre-Formatting is required this option is ignored.

Note: You must use only the disk density selected here when you are preformatting the diskettes.

Formatting: When creating an archive on removable media this option specifies whether any preformatting of the media should take place.

No-Preformatting - Only available space on the disk will be used.

Quick Format - All files and directories will be wiped from the disk (the disk must already be low level formatted to use this option).

DOS-Format - A full low level format of the disk will take place prior to archive operations.

Note: Splitting options are ignored for non-removable media.

Encryption:

Encrypt: Set this option to encrypt archived files using the specified password.

Password: A password with up to 65 characters.

Note: There must be a valid password if the Encrypt option is selected.

Temp Path:

- **Use Temp Path:** Causes update operation on an archive to first make a copy of the archive before beginning.
- **Temp Path:** Enter the directory path where archive temp files are created.
- **Browse:** Click Browse or press Alt+B to select another directory to use for Temp files.

CAUTION: Only disable this option if your sure that update or freshen operations will not fail as damage to the archive will result.

- Click OK or press ENTER to accept the options.
- Click Cancel or press ESC to cancel the selection.

Delete - Dialog Help

- **Ready to Delete:** The File that is about to be deleted.
- List Box: Lists the files as they are deleted.

Prompt for confirmation: If selected will prompt the user before each file is deleted.

- Click Delete or press ENTER to start the delete operation.
- Click Cancel or press ESC to cancel the operation.
- Click Options or press Alt+O to change the Zip Options.
