

LotusScript Help is not available

The LotusScript help files are not installed on your system. You can reinstall Word Pro, and specify that LotusScript Help should be installed.

LotusScript Help is only necessary if you plan to use the Script programming language to develop scripts. You do not need it to record and play simple scripts.

1. Insert the CD-ROM in the appropriate drive, and close the drive door.
2. Choose Run from the Start menu.
3. Type **x:install**, where *x* is the appropriate drive.
4. Click OK. Follow the instructions in the Install windows.
5. Choose "Customize features - Manual install" in the "Install Options & Word Pro Folder" dialog box.

Note If you choose the Default or Minimum installation, you will not have the option to install the help files.

6. Click Next.
7. Select "LotusScript Help for Word Pro" on the Word Pro tab.
8. Deselect all other features on all the tabs.

If you leave other features selected, they will be reinstalled.
