Overview

Lotus ScreenCam 97 for Windows 95 is a fast, easy and inexpensive way to show audiences what you mean when you can't be there in person. ScreenCam virtually turns a PC into a VCR that records every click, scroll and action on its screen. Plus users can add captions and the sound of their voice. Combine up to 20 movie segments to create movies describing the latest proposal, product demonstration or online tutorial. Create instant PC movies, and share them with others without the high cost of authoring products. Viewers can play movies back, even if they don't have ScreenCam installed.

Key Features and Benefits

- Windows 95 integration ScreenCam 97 support files names of up to 256 characters, full Windows 95 shell integration, Quick View, 32-bit application support, tabbed dialogues and more.
- Internet A few simple keystrokes configures a user's Web browser to automatically play ScreenCam movies when the ScreenCam icon is clicked from a Web page.
- Pause Movie designers can plan movies in logical, smaller length segments, record them, and then
 append them together seamlessly, eliminating the need to re-record the entire movie to improve only
 a small portion of it. The Jump to Segment button allows you to navigate quickly to a particular
 location in a movie.
- Captions Content, format and attributes for captions are easily created and incorporated to a ScreenCam screen track, for movies that do not use sound. Assign hot keys to recall captions to the proper place in a screen track.
- **Preferences** Improve the final "cut" of your ScreenCam movies in advance, by choosing preferences for a movie that control cropping, font fidelity between the system a movie is recorded on, and the one it is played back on.
- Thumbnails Generate thumbnails automatically for movies created using any version of ScreenCam; generate thumbnails for color depths greater than 256 colors.
- Manage Movies Visual graphics display screen track and soundtrack size, and the potential compression results, to better manage the disk space needed for ScreenCam movies.
 - Movie descriptors include the name of the person and company who originally created the movie, as well as the current user information and statistics about movie segment size.
 - Movie size and file size offer additional information for better disk-space utilization.
 - A temporary directory for ScreenCam movies is user selectable.

Estimated System Requirements

ScreenCam 97 runs on IBM or compatible certified machines for use with Windows 95. A VGA 16-color or higher graphics adapter and monitor are required, as well as a parallel port or sound card-enabled device supported by Windows 95, speaker(s) or headphones, a microphone and a mouse. 10MB free disk space is recommended for recording.

ScreenCam 97 for Windows 95 will be available through Lotus Authorized Resellers for an estimated retail price (ERP) of \$149. Upgrades for ScreenCam 2.1 are available for an ERP of \$59.
