



The Lotus[®] InfoBox is an efficient, comprehensive, centralized tool for editing the properties of any object. With the InfoBox, all editing is "dynamic" so that changes made to any object are displayed on the page as the user makes them. The InfoBox is consistent across the entire Lotus product line.







Speaker Notes

Zooming capabilities and text controls simplify the process of composing speaker notes.

Headers and Footers

Header and Footer options deliver control and ease of use.

- ♦ Page numbers, date/time, and file name can all be entered with the click of a button.
- ♦ Users can control the Header and Footer text typeface and alignment.

Formatting

Enhanced text formatting features give users flexibility and control in working with presentation text.

- ♦ Named Styles make global text changes for all or selected pages a snap.
- Six predefined Named Styles are provided for each SmartMaster. Users can create new styles and redefine existing styles in the InfoBox.
- ♦ 42 pre-made bullet types are included. And, any Clip Art image can be used as a bullet type.
- Spacing controls let users adjust the spacing between bullets and adjacent text, or between lines in a bulleted list.
- ♦ A global typeface change can be made to all text in the presentation by simply issuing one command, which will also update all named styles.
- ♦ The "Clear Overrides" command removes "locally-applied" text edits.
- ♦ Shadowed, Superscript, and Subscript attributes (among others) let users give special treatment to selected text.

- ♦ Users can easily reorder bulleted text using drag and drop.

- Speeds content entry, as users don't have to "Click here..."

- Eliminates the need to cut, copy, and paste when reordering bulleted lists, or when lists spill over onto a second slide.


Lotus Chart

Lotus Chart is a high-quality data charting tool found in Freelance Graphics and shared across all Lotus SmartSuite 97 applications. With Lotus Chart, users enjoy easy, seamless integration, and increased productivity when working with charts in all SmartSuite products.

- ♦ Users can create their own chart layouts by saving chart attributes. Layouts can be applied to any chart created in Freelance Graphics or any Lotus SmartSuite product.
- ♦ Lotus Chart features a live preview of a user's chart in the Data Window, providing an accurate, current picture as the chart is created.

Advanced data linking options in the Freelance[®] File Viewer make it easier to generate "chart reports" from data that exists in external sources, such as 1-2-3[®] worksheets.

- A fully integrated Animation Player means animations are faster, smoother, and more powerful than OLE-based implementations.
- ♦ Eight special multimedia SmartMasters include built-in animations and Screen Show effects. Users simply add their content for ready-made multimedia presentations.
- ♦ 75 ready-made 3-D animated clips with common business themes let users drive home the point with pizzazz.
- ♦ The "Hide Slides" command lets users selectively hide pages during screen shows, making it practical for users to recycle presentations for different audiences.
- Screen Show effects can be applied to a full page or to individual objects on a page. Individual objects can have their own Screen Show transitions, and sequencing and the appearance of each object can be set individually, so that information is delivered in the proper order at the proper time.


Rehearse Mode

Rehearse Mode lets users practice their presentations while viewing speaker notes and tracking the time it takes to deliver a single page or an entire presentation.



- ♦ Easy-to-understand language guides the user to the next level and eliminates confusion.
- ♦ Access to information on other related tasks is available if needed.





- ✤ Table of Contents Browser features presentation page names so that users can go directly to the page they want to view.
- Users can post native Freelance Graphics files on the Web, and include a link to the Lotus Home Page from which Internet users can download and install the Mobile Screen Show player. This lets viewers experience all of the robust multimedia functionality of a native Freelance Graphics Screen Show, without having Freelance Graphics installed on their system.

- ♦ File-Save to Internet lets users save their presentations to the Internet (FTP) servers quickly and easily, directly from the Freelance Graphics File Menu.
- ♦ File-Open to the Internet lets users open files from Internet (FTP) Servers directly from the Freelance Graphics File Menu.

- Lets users anywhere in the world share and collaborate on presentations, via the Internet.
- Gives users remote access to their Freelance Graphics presentations, from wherever they're working.

Staying Connected: Collaboration Made Easy

Utilizing Lotus' unique Team Computing technologies, Freelance Graphics helps businesspeople collaborate on and share presentations, and improves the way they create, review, and edit presentations. Freelance Graphics helps make users more productive because they start with the best possible input and can easily share their work with others.

Freelance Graphics provides a rich set of innovative team computing tools to let users quickly and easily share, communicate, and collaborate with team members using visual information. These team computing and collaboration tools deliver:

- ♦ An electronic alternative to cumbersome, manual processes.
- ♦ Easy access to input from coworkers no matter what their communications infrastructure might be: LAN or WAN, e-mail, Lotus Notes, the Internet, Intranet, or "sneaker net."
- ♦ Quick and intuitive techniques for retrieving and re-using the work of others.
- ♦ New options for distributing work for review and sharing, or publishing the final result.

TeamReview

TeamReview is an automated, on-line process that enables teams to collaborate on presentations. The feature lets a presentation author electronically distribute a draft presentation to a specified set of reviewers. Presentation reviewers then electronically comment on the presentation using simple, accessible markup tools. TeamReview makes it easy to solicit and incorporate feedback from a broad group of reviewers, enabling authors to create more compelling, up-to-date communications with greater buy-in across the organization. And, reviewers find it easier than ever before to contribute to other team members' presentations. The Team Review Process in Freelance Graphics involves *three easy steps*:

Step 1: The presentation author distributes a presentation for review

- ♦ Presentations are easily distributed for review via floppy disks, the LAN (public directory), e-mail, or a Lotus Notes database.
- ♦ An author can optionally choose to notify reviewers via e-mail that their input is needed at time of distribution.



Team Review

Distribute a presentation on disk; over e-mail, the network, or the Internet/intranet; or by posting it to a Lotus Notes Database.

Step 2: Reviewer(s) review the presentation

- Reviewers provide comments using custom-designed tools that facilitate the review process, including electronic sticky notes and color-coded markup tools.
- Quick Comments, such as "misspelling" or "punctuation error" give reviewers the fastest way to comment on presentations. Reviewers can add their own Quick Comments to the list.
- Reviewers have the option to view others' comments, helping to eliminate duplication of effort.

Step 3: An author incorporates reviewers' comments into the final presentation

- All reviewers' comments are consolidated into one presentation file for the author, regardless of the method of distribution.

TeamShow

With TeamShow, users can deliver point-to-point on-line Screen Show presentations to others in remote locations.

- In Freelance Graphics 97, TeamShow includes support for *multiple* points of display. Using the presentation delivery collaboration tool, users can lead a number of remote audiences through a presentation.
- Presenters can privately display, create, or edit speaker notes while conferencing with a remote audience. (Speaker notes appear only on the presenter's screen.)
- "Ready" and "wait" messages on the Status Bar keep presenters and viewers in synch during their conference.
- ♦ Viewers can utilize Freelance Graphics' Mobile Screen Show player to participate in a TeamShow, so they don't need a copy of Freelance Graphics.
- ♦ As TeamShow also works over two machines connected via cable, presenters can display their slides and speaker notes on one PC, while a second PC displays only the slides to the audience.

Teams that leverage SmartMaster content capabilities work faster and smarter and avoid "recreating the wheel" each time they need to prepare a presentation.

- ♦ SmartMaster templates offer a wide variety of timesaving content capabilities.
- Customized, instructional "Click here to..." prompt text, filled-in text, graphics and diagrams and SmartCharts (preformatted data charts) make it easier than ever to provide truly valuable content for team members to learn from and build upon.

Although Freelance Graphics' team computing tools work within a wide range communication environments — over the Internet, LANs and e-mail, for example — Freelance Graphics also includes features designed specifically to enhance the value of Lotus Notes.

TeamReview and Lotus Notes

Both authors and reviewers enjoy unique benefits when presentations are posted for review to a Lotus Notes Presentation Library or other Notes[™] database. Lotus Notes provides services which other distribution/storage mechanisms do not. And TeamReview leverages these services to streamline the review process even further for those who have Lotus Notes:

♦ New in Freelance Graphics 97, TeamReview lets multiple reviewers collaborate on a presentation simultaneously and provides support for Notes R4 databases.

- ♦ Open & Save to Lotus Notes lets users browse Lotus Notes databases directly from the File Menu in Freelance Graphics and makes it easy to post presentations directly to Lotus Notes databases.
- ♦ WAN and mobile users gain "uninterrupted" access to presentations by exploiting Lotus Notes replication capabilities.
- Notes provides access control and security so that a presentation's author can decide to prevent others from accessing the comments of certain users.
- ♦ Lotus Notes delivers easy and automated presentation management capabilities; Notes/FX[™] information is automatically published to the Notes database so that users can sort by presentation name, author name, or other criterion.
- ♦ Reviewer comments are consolidated into the presentation seamlessly and automatically.
- ♦ Any Notes database can be "TeamReview-enabled" by automatically copying the correct Notes forms and views into the Notes database during the posting process.

With Freelance Graphics, accessing and sharing presentations across the Internet/intranet is as easy as opening or saving a file. Using the standard File-Open and File-Save dialogs in Freelance Graphics, users can open any presentation from an FTP (File Transfer Protocol) or a World Wide Web server via the Internet. Users can also save presentations to an FTP server.

- ♦ Freelance Graphics maintains a list of frequently-used FTP server addresses for easy access.
