ScreenCam is also excellent for annotating documents, whether they be complex financial statements, special order forms, expense reports, or articles to share with clients or colleagues — an easy way to energize, clarify, and personalize messages.

When communicating within the on-line environment, ScreenCam adds value by increasing the effectiveness of the message. For example, in addition to, or in place of, a file (e.g., a spreadsheet) attached to an e-mail, users can include a ScreenCam movie that captures the spreadsheet with a voice-over discussing the particular points of interest.

The adage, "a picture is worth a thousand words," is definitely applicable: with voice, the message becomes that much more powerful. And with manageable file sizes, ScreenCam movies are finding favor on the Web, in e-mail, and over networks for delivering all types of multimedia communication.

The following table compares ScreenCam 97, Lotus' full-featured show-and-tell software for PCs, to Camcorder 97, a utility bundled with Microsoft Office. Unlike Microsoft Camcorder 97, ScreenCam 97 can be deployed on standard PCs running either Windows 3.1 or Windows 95. Additionally, ScreenCam's caption features ensure that PC users, including those who do not have sophisticated sound hardware, can playback Lotus screen movies — whereas Microsoft Camcorder movies are useful only to people with full multimedia sound capabilities. After reviewing this table, you will see there is only one choice.
