## **How to Play**

### **Mouse**

The left click on the falling block (lith) to rotate the lith, and in sides of the lith to shift the lith. The right click to drop the lith.

### **Keyboard**

To move right, press '6' on numberpad or right arrow key.

To move left, press '4' on numberpad or left arrow key.

To move down, press '8' on numberpad.

To rotate, press '5' on numberpad.

To drop, press '2' on numberpad.

To pause, press 'Escape'.

Up and down arrow keys and space bar can be assigned. Select 'Assign Keys' from Option menu.

### **Score**

When completing lines, the lines disappear and the score increases. The more lines completed at the same time, the more points added.

1 line ... 1 point

2 lines ... 5 points

3 lines ... 10 points

4 lines ... 20 points

5 lines ... 50 points

6 lines ...100 points

## **Select Liths**

You can select liths from the total of sixty kinds of liths. Left click on the lith to select so that a frame around the lith will appear. Left click again on the lith to cancel.
