Game New Command

Selecting this item from the menu will invoke a dialog box asking if you are sure you want to start a new game. If you select Yes, a new game will begin. Selecting No will cancel the request.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Game, then clicking on New.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+G, then N.

Shortcut Key - F10.

Game Save Game Command

Selecting this item from the menu will save the game currently in progress. It will prompt you to save the current game if there is a previously saved game. Saving the current game will overwrite the old saved game. The game will continue.

This command is only active during a game. A completed game cannot be saved.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Game, then clicking on Save Game.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+G, then G.

Game Save Match Command

Selecting this item from the menu will save the results of the just finished game to a match file. It will invoke a dialog box asking you which match file to save the match to, and which coach to save to Team 1. The Save Match Command does not overwrite previously stored data. It sums the results of the just finished game and the match that you selected and stores them. You must input which coach to save to Team 1 because the matches are saved in a specific order. (If you were the Team 1 coach when the match was saved, and you are the Team 2 in the second game, and you used different initials, the computer would not know where to save your game.) Team 1 refers to the first listed team in the Match Selection portion of the dialog box.

This command is only active when a game is complete, and has not been saved to a match.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Game, then clicking on Save Match.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+G, then M.

Game Delete Match Command

Selecting this item from the menu will invoke a dialog box asking you which match to delete. If the cancel button is chosen, no match will be deleted.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Game, then clicking on Delete Match.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+G, then D.

Game Playing Field Command

Selecting this item from the menu will display the playing field. It is used after viewing game or match statistics. The game clock will restart following this command, unless the game is complete.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Game, then clicking on Playing Field.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+G, then P.

Game Game Statistics Command

Selecting this item from the menu will display the current game statistics. The game clock will stop when this is selected. To return to play, Select Game Playing Field.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Game, then clicking on Game Statistics.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+G, then S.

Game Match Statistics Command

Selecting this item from the menu will invoke a dialog box asking which match to display. The game clock will stop when this is selected. To return to play, Select Game Playing Field.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Game, then clicking on Match Statistics.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+G, then T.

Game Exit Command

Selecting this item from the menu will invoke a dialog box asking if you are sure you want to quit the game. If you select Yes, WINTREK will terminate. Selecting No will cancel the request.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Game, then clicking on Exit.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+G, then X.

Shortcut Key - Shift+F10.

Run Line Plunge Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Line Plunge play. It is designed for short yardage (1 to 2 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Run, then clicking on Line Plunge.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+R, then L.

Run Off Tackle Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Off Tackle play. It is designed for short to medium yardage (2 to 4 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Run, then clicking on Off Tackle.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+R, then O.

Run End Run Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the End Run play. It is designed for medium yardage (3 to 6 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Run, then clicking on End Run.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+R, then E.

Run Trap Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Trap play. It is designed for short yardage (2 to 4 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Run, then clicking on Trap.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+R, then T.

Run Reverse Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Reverse play. It is designed for medium to long yardage (3 to 6 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Run, then clicking on Reverse.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+R, then R.

Run Draw Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Draw play. It is designed for medium yardage (2 to 5 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Run, then clicking on Line Draw.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+R, then D.

Pass Short Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Short Pass play. It is designed for short yardage (5 - 8 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Pass, then clicking on Short.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+P, then S.

Pass Medium Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Medium Pass play. It is designed for medium yardage (8 - 15 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Pass, then clicking on Medium.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+P, then M.

Pass Long Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Long Pass play. It is designed for long yardage (15 - 25 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Pass, then clicking on Long.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+P, then L.

Pass Screen Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Screen Pass play. It is designed for short yardage (5 - 8 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Pass, then clicking on Screen.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+P, then C.

Pass Sideline Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Sideline Pass play. It is designed for medium yardage (8 - 15 yds). It is a good play to stop the clock.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Pass, then clicking on Sideline.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+P, then D.

Pass Halfback Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Halfback Pass play. It is designed for long yardage (15 - 25 yds).

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Pass, then clicking on Halfback.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+P, then H.

Kick Kickoff Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Kickoff play. This command is only active when it is a valid play.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Kick, then clicking on Kickoff.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+K, then K.

Kick Onside Kickoff Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Onside Kickoff play. This command is only active when it is a valid play.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Kick, then clicking on Onside Kickoff.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+K, then O.

Kick Punt Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Punt play. This command is only active when it is a valid play.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Kick, then clicking on Punt.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+K, then P.

Kick Field Goal Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call the Field Goal play. This command is only active when it is a valid play. The longest field goal that can be made is 63 yds.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Kick, then clicking on Field Goal.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+K, then F.

Timeout Offense Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call a timeout for the Offense. This command is only active when it is a valid selection.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Timeout, then clicking on Offense.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+T, then O.

Timeout Defense Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call a timeout for the Defense. This command is only active when it is a valid selection.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Timeout, then clicking on Defense.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+T, then D.

Help Help Command

Selecting this item from the menu will start up the Windows 3.0 Help Engine to display game procedures and information.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Help, then clicking on Help.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+H, then H.

Shortcut Key - F1.

Help About Command

Selecting this item from the menu will call a dialog box to display program development information.

The command is invoked by:

Mouse - Clicking on Help, then clicking on About.

Keyboard - Pressing Alt+H, then A.
