

Date Edit 1.0

Date Edit is a shell extension for Windows 95/98/NT that enables you to change the date and time of your files from inside the Windows Explorer. All you have to do is to open the Windows Explorer, right-click the item(s) of interest and choose *Edit Date* in the context menu.

The **Date Edit** shell extension is very easy to use and it lets you choose the new date of your files from a fancy calendar. The only restriction on using **Date Edit** is that it requires you to have the Microsoft Internet Explorer 3.0 or later installed on your computer because it needs the system libraries distributed by the Microsoft Internet Explorer.

This version of **Date Edit** is the first release of the product. If you encounter any problems or difficulties using the **Date Edit** shell extension or if you have suggestions for future releases please do not hesitate to drop us a few lines by e-mail.

This product is **freeware**.

If you don't want to change the date of the items but only the time click the box to the left of the date to remove the check mark and disable date editing.

Displays the time of the item being edited.

To change the time of the item click the unit (hour, minute or second) in question then click the spin button to the right of the time to increase or decrease the time.

You can also change the time of the item using the arrow keys on the keyboard.

Note: The time resolution of items located on a FAT formatted media is 2 seconds, i.e. you can only set the time to even seconds (0, 2, 4, 6, 8...).

To change the time of the items click the unit (hour, minute or second) in question then click the spin button to the right of the time to increase or decrease the time.

You can also change the time of the items using the arrow keys on the keyboard.

If you don't want to change the time of the items but only the date click the box to the left of the time to remove the check mark and disable time editing.

Note: The time resolution of items located on a FAT formatted media is 2 seconds, i.e. you can only set the time to even seconds (0, 2, 4, 6, 8...).
