Mini-Dialogue Strategies

1. Be careful of vocabulary. Words with more than one meaning will be tested in Section One of the TOEFL. Listen for idioms. See checkpoints L√1 through L√3 for practice.
2. Be careful of sounds. Look for sound-alikes in answer choices. Do not be tricked by words and expressions that sound alike but which have different meanings. See checkpoints L√4 through L√6 for practice.
3. Listen carefully to the second speaker. Listen for strong emotions, such as surprise, anger, or frustration. Listen for strong emphasis on certain words or phrases. Listen for strong emotions in the second speaker's question.
4. Be careful of tricky spoken structures such as contractions, negatives, causative verbs, conditions, tag questions, modals, passives, and relationship signals. See L√7 through L√10 for practice.
5. Listen carefully to the second speaker. The second speaker always gives important information. The
