

ScriptWorx 4.0 - Extending the Interface

Many of the files mentioned in this document can be found in the \Extensions\ sub-directory of the ScriptWorx program folder. They each have the file extension .slf which means 'SoftLite File'. Renaming these files may stop ScriptWorx from functioning correctly.

ScriptWorx uses text files for the following aspects of the interface. This allows one file to be modified on one computer, and copied to another with ease (ie. No more registry tweaks or recompiling of any code).

- In-Line Code Completion - slcompli.slf
- AutoComplete Templates - slcompla.slf
- JavaScript Events - slevents.slf
- Open/Save Dialog Favorites Paths - slperson.slf
- Recent files - slrecent.slf

In the \Ftp folder are files which are used to customize the FTP Profiles, which used to be located in the \FTPProfiler directory. Each file may be tailored to your needs, and specific information must go on each line:

| Line | Information | Example |
|------|--|-------------------------|
| 1 | The server to connect to (exc. ftp://) | ftp.mysite.com |
| 2 | Username | anonymous |
| 3 | Password | my@e-mail.address.co.uk |
| 4 | Port Number (usually 21) | 21 |

This can be useful if you have a group of people who each have access to the same server, and each file need only be modified so as to change the name and password if required. These files have a .prof extensions (ie. 'Profile').
