### **Uploading to Site:**

The robots.txt file should be placed only in the root directory of your site.

### **Usage Instructions:**

This example gives you a file that search engines look for on the root directory of a site, and it allows them to see which directories on your site you do not wish people to have access to, or allow search engines to index.

This may range from members-only directories to a CGI-BIN, PHP or Scripts folder on a web server. CGI-BIN's should not be indexed by search engines, as this may present a security risk to your server. Uploading to UNIX is not a problem with this file (you should not have to set permissions).

The **disallow** commands you see will prevent a search engine indexing any file in the directory named next to it.
