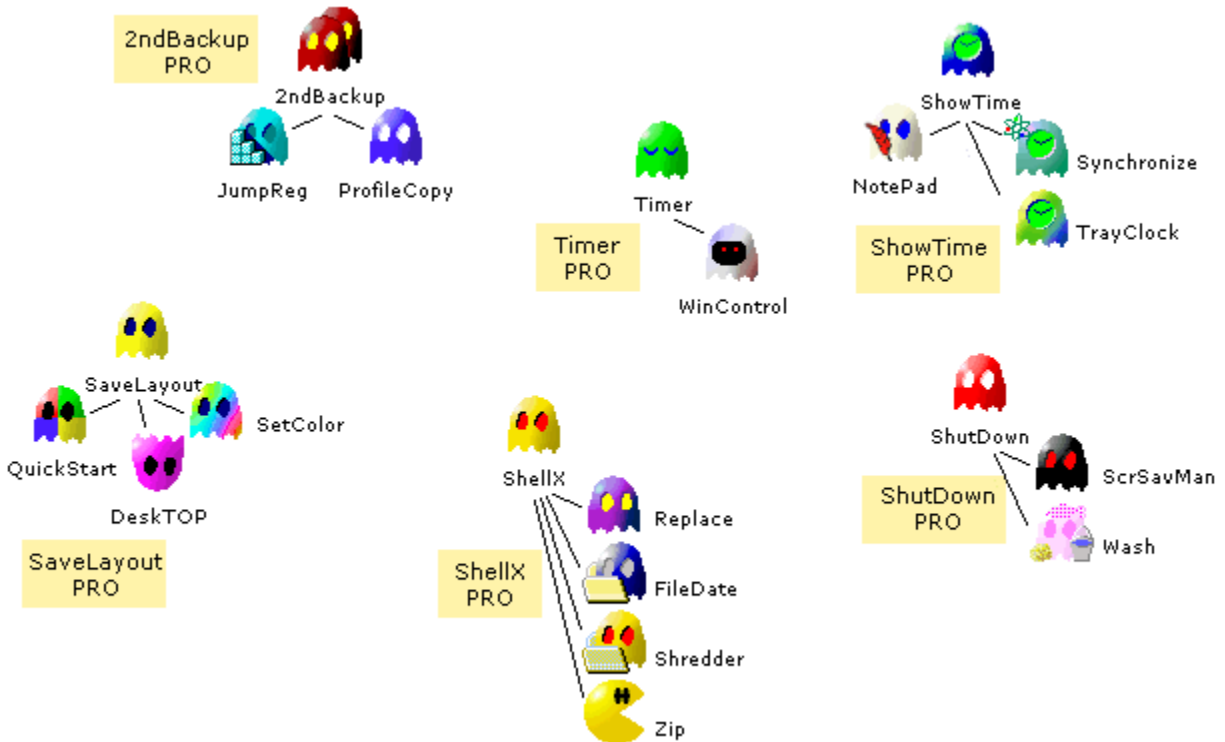

Frequently Asked Questions

What is 12Ghosts all about?

12Ghosts is a bundle of a wide variety of utilities that serve to accelerate and to facilitate your working with your computer. With 2ndBackup let the changes you make to your documents be saved automatically. And 12Ghosts ShutDown lets you control the whole busy and complicated process of shutting down, restarting, logging off, etc. The list just goes on and on.

The 12Ghosts were carefully designed and are constantly enhanced to support and speed up working with Windows 95-2000. All 12Ghosts support command line options for easy automation. They work together smoothly and provide a comprehensive user interface, intuitive for new users.

How can I start using 12Ghosts?

You first need to copy 12Ghosts to your computer by clicking [here](#). Setup is a straight forward, one-click task that everybody can do. The download time is only three minutes

at 28.8 Kbps and the installation is quick and never requires a restart. You can install new versions over any previous version without hesitation. And we guaranty that uninstall works as easy, fast and reliable as the setup.

Why should I register?

You can try 12Ghosts for 30 days to decide whether it works for you. After the evaluation period a registration fee for a full version is required. This is better than a money-back guarantee because you can actually use 12Ghosts and see what the Ghosts are capable of before ever having to register. Network and Unattended Installation

To install a single Ghost or the 12Ghosts package you can just push the necessary files to a client's binary folder. If the Ghosts, however, are currently running on the client, you need to execute the setup locally. Setup will then stop all related programs automatically. Unzip all files into a new folder and start setup.exe. Use the following command line parameters for an unattended installation.

- /silent** For unattended installations.
- /path:** Install path. Default is the folder where the program was installed last time. If this is the first installation the subfolder "12Ghosts <app-name>" in the system's "Program Files" folder is created. This folder is usually at the root of the same partition as the Windows folder (but it can be changed at "HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion" - "ProgramFilesDir").
- /noshort** Don't create shortcut(s) in START menu. Default: create shortcuts.
- /nostart** Don't start app(s) after setup is complete, 12Ghosts will start tray-based Ghosts silently. Default: start apps.
- /language:N** The initial language used for setup.

Since the 12Ghosts package is rather small with an installed size of only 1.5 MB it is possible to copy all files to the clients' disks. This provides for faster, guaranteed access since usage does not depend on network availability and throughput. You can, as well, keep all binary files on a network server. None of the 12Ghosts needs write access to the installation folder.

The "Languages" subfolder is not required as long as you select the language "English (Original)". Nor is the "Sounds" subfolder required, but recommended for a better recognition of 12Ghosts events. If no sound system is available you can do without the Sounds subfolder.

You may want to start a properly set up 12Ghosts Settings ".12g" file after setup is complete. This is an unrivaled easy way to add common settings appropriately. The 12Ghosts Settings ".12g" file can also contain the registration settings. For 12Ghosts the license information is stored at "HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\PACT Software\Ghosts" in the value "RegCode".

12Ghosts Settings ".12g" files are automatically associated with one of the 12Ghost. Use "/s" for a silent import of all settings in the ".12g" file.

I get an error message while registering hotkey!?

Please try specifying another hotkey, Windows seems to have difficulties to register the one you chose (General Options - click in the Hotkey field and press a "normal", unused key combination, for example Ctrl+Alt+a).

The start-up animation does not display correctly. What can I do?

- Don't use a Windows 95 display driver on Windows 98.
- Try updating to the latest display driver, which is certainly provided on the homepage of your graphics adapter vendor. See your PC's handbook or invoice on which graphics processor you have.
- Please update to a newer version of DirectX. It can be downloaded free from <http://www.microsoft.com/>. If "Ghost" and "Icon" are the same, then you don't have DirectX installed.
- If the "Ghost" or "Icon" animation has a black rectangle, then your graphic card does not support transparent movements. Consider a new graphic card or try the Ghost (GDI) animation.

Do the 12Ghosts have a low memory usage?

Yes. We took every possible step to reduce memory usage as much as possible. Compared to other programs we develop in C, and don't use VB, MFC, or COM, which all would require large DLLs. In other words, 12Ghosts executables are very small and handy. Basically, you can look at the size of the programs in the installation path, sum it up, add 30%, and you have the memory usage. If you only take those running all the time, that is, the ones that can be minimized to a tray icon, they need about 800 KB for the program code and 200 KB for internal variables, **about one magabyte of main memory**.

What is rather confusing, if you have ever looked at the "Memory Usage" counter, for example, in the System Monitor or Task Manager, you find what usually is called the "Working Set". The size of the Working Set will change over time and depends on overall system activity.

The programs may be assigned 3 MB of memory, but they don't use it. With 64 MB main memory, for example, and only a few programs running, you still have free main memory left. That's why Windows decides to let the 12Ghosts claim the unused 2 MB memory for now. But if main memory becomes short, the unused 2 MB will be freed up and used by other programs. Then, and only then, the "Memory Usage" will indeed display the correct memory footprint.

CleanSweep creates a log entry everytime a Ghost is starting, why?

All Ghosts recreate their associations with the .12g files, as well as SaveLayout with the .sl files. This requires a change in HKEY_CLASSES_ROOT and CleanSweep obviously doesn't like that. We believe that this feature of 12Ghosts helps to make the file associations more stable, but you can turn it off. The easiest way to avoid this problem, of course, is to stop CleanSweep as long as you are not installing software.

To stop all Ghosts from writing to HKEY_CLASSES_ROOT (except Setup of course, and ProfileCopy at restore), please add the DWORD value "DontWriteToHKCR" to the following registry key and set it to 1.

Something is not working as expected. What can I do?

A common issue with many newer applications is an outdated comctl32.dll, a system DLL responsible for display buttons, check boxes, and so on. It is easy to update to the latest version of comctl32.dll, version 4.72, which you can find on the [12Ghosts.com download page](#). In any other case we'll be happy to help, just contact [12Ghosts](#).

How do I ...

How do I close a DOS box after I'm finished with it?

There's an easier way than changing the default PIF for command.com: start command.com with parameters = '/c batchfile.bat'. This closes a DOS box when you've finished with it!

How do I reorder the sequence of buttons on the taskbar?

- 1 Activate each application in the order you want to have the buttons displayed
- 2 Start Quick - Hide all Windows
- 3 Start Quick - Unhide Windows

How do I reduce the number of tray icons?

You can turn off the tray icon and keep the program running. To access any Ghost start 12Ghosts in the Start menu or use the hotkey or use Quick and select the Ghost in the right column! You can also try the free movable icon that may be moved to anywhere on

the screen.

How do I move the free movable icon without the mouse?

You can move the free movable icon with the arrow keys Up, Down, Left, Right, if it has the focus after moving it with the mouse or after a double click on the icon.

How do I turn off the Ghost Animation for all 12Ghosts at once?

- 1** Open General Options by clicking with the right mouse button on any Ghost's tray icon.
- 2** Select the animation (None)
- 3** Click on the small button left from the animation drop-down lists
- 4** Click OK to apply the selected animation to all 12Ghosts.

How do I change General options for all 12Ghosts at once?

In the General Options window select "Apply to All 12". This will apply all selected options to all 12Ghosts.

How do I save all 12Ghosts settings?

In the General Options click on **Save** and select a path to which the settings will be stored. For example, if you have to reinstall Windows you don't need to set up your carefully selected options again. To restore the options you can just double-click the .12g file.

How do I move the 12Ghosts entry from Programs in the Start menu?

- 1** Click with the *right* mouse button on the Start button
- 2** Select Open
- 3** In the window that opens move the mouse pointer over the first entry *12Ghosts*
- 4** Press and *hold* the left mouse button
- 5** Move the mouse one line down over *Programs* until *Programs* is also highlighted in dark blue
- 6** Release the left mouse button

How many ways do I have to activate help?

- Just click with the right mouse button on any control
- Click with the left mouse button on the question mark in the title bar and then on the control or menu you would like to know more about
- Press the F1 key when a control or a menu entry has the focus
- Click on the Help button
- Select Help in the menu

General Options

One-touch control over all 12Ghosts

General Options is the same for all 12Ghosts. You can apply the settings in General Options to all 12Ghosts at once by pressing **Apply to All 12**. This will affect all twelve Ghosts (where applicable, and leave the hotkeys untouched).

You can also click on the small buttons to the left of each option in order to set just this one option the same for all twelve Ghosts.

Icons and Sounds

- **Taskbar Tray Icon** - Display or remove the taskbar tray icon. Click on the tray icon with the left mouse button to activate the default action. Click with the *right* mouse button to activate the context menu.
- **Free Movable Icon** - Display or remove the free movable icon. Click on the movable icon with the left mouse button to activate the default action. Click with the *right* mouse button to activate the context menu.

The Free Movable Icon can be moved anywhere on the screen and it will always stay on top. There is most often enough room on the top of the screen where most windows just display a half empty blue bar or you can use the area to the right where

the vertical scroll bar usually leaves some room. But make sure that you really *move* the icon and not just click it because in the latter case the default action will be started.

0 You can move this icon with the arrow keys, up, down, left, or right, as long as it has the focus. Either double-click on the icon, or right-click and press Escape to set the focus to the movable icon.

- **Icons Animated** - Some tray icons have animation features: SaveLayout closes its eyes and lets the icon jump onto the desktop while saving and restoring, 2ndBackup visualizes the copying process, Timer "wakes up" for a moment when it re-checks all timers, and ShutDown starts flashing if the cursor is over or near the icon.
- **Mute All Sounds** - Many actions are accompanied by fitting sounds. These sounds are intended to make the user aware of certain situations. You can customize most sounds in each Ghost or turn off specific sounds. With this option you can mute all sounds at once.

Shortcuts

- **At start up add shortcut to the Startup folder** - Add a shortcut to the Startup folder when a Ghost starts. This will ensure that the program is launched automatically every time Windows is started. You can open and control the Startup folder by clicking on START with the *right* mouse button, select open, double-click Programs, then double-click Startup.
- **At manual Quit, remove Startup shortcut** - You might want to have the Startup shortcut removed when you manually stop the program (but not when Windows is shut down). The idea here is that you would probably want a Ghost to remain in the Startup folder if you were using it when you last shut down Windows. If you close the Ghost yourself, however, during a Windows session, then you would probably not want it to open again the next time you start up Windows.
- **Shortcut in Start Menu** - Create or remove a shortcut in the Start button menu. You can open the Start folder by clicking on START with the *right* mouse button and selecting open.
- **Shortcut in Start - Programs** - Create or remove a shortcut in the Start - Programs menu. You can access the Programs folder by clicking on START with the *right* mouse button, selecting open, and double-clicking Programs.
- **Shortcut on Desktop** - Create or remove a shortcut on the Desktop.

Help, Animation, Language

- **Pop-Up Help** - Change the Pop-Up Help (Bubble Help, ToolTip) delay time. This is the time you need to hover with the mouse pointer over a control until the pop-up help appears. Drag the slider to the left to have the help pop-up immediately, further to the right to increase the delay time, or to the far right to turn off the pop-up help completely.
- **Language** - Select a different language here. Note that you need to close the General

Options as well as the settings window for the changes to take effect. The next time you open the window the selected language will be used.

You can change the animation type, the speed of the startup animation, as well as the sound that should be played during the animation effect.

- **HotKey** - Change the window hotkey. A window hotkey only works while the Ghost is running. You can make the Ghost invisible, however, by not displaying a tray or movable icon. This way you can still access the Ghost via the hotkey.

Save and Restore All Settings

0 Also in General Options you find four buttons to save, restore, or completely remove all user defined settings. This includes program settings as well as the setting in General Options. You might want to transfer all settings from one computer to another, or to a new Windows installation, or just save them just in case (say, for example, before somebody else starts working at your computer). It is recommended that you also copy the settings file to a backup media. Make sure that you first save your settings before restoring or removing settings!

Wait before sending the second close request. You may want to wait a couple of seconds for all applications to process the first shutdown request.

Definitely terminate ALL programs WITHOUT SAVING ANY DATA!!! Although this does work pretty fast, you will lose all unsaved information! Use only in extenuating circumstances!

Wait a bit before definitely terminating all programs. You should wait at least another 10 seconds so that applications have enough time to save internal data.

Display ShutDown settings.

[Click here to close all programs, shut down and power off the computer.](#)

Note: The computer hardware must support the power-off signal. You may want to look into the BIOS setup and Control Panel to see if power management is available and activated. Native NT 4.0 does not support power management.

Close all programs and shut down the computer.

TIP: Hold CTRL to do a standard shutdown directly without run and clear.

Close all programs and restart the computer.

TIP: Hold CTRL just to restart without run and clear.

Close all programs and log on as a different user.

TIP: Hold CTRL just to logoff without run and clear.

Enter standby mode. Your computer must be set up to support power management and standby mode.

Start the currently selected screen saver. If password protection is activated this will effectively LOCK the computer after 5 seconds.

The icons will flash when the mouse pointer is near. After all, a single click might turn off your computer.

Flash rate when the mouse cursor is in the click zone.

The warning sound will only play when the mouse cursor is over the tray icon or free movable icon.

Play the currently selected warning sound.

Change the warning sound. You can select almost any file to be played here. A *.WAV file will be played in a loop.

Let the icon flash if the mouse cursor is within a certain range near the icon.

Activate all sounds in ShutDown.

Set the default action, modify list of menu commands.

Change sound and animation settings for the ShutDown Icon, blink frequency, and buzzer sound.

Change settings for 12Wash, that will cover your tracks in Windows automatically before shutting down.

Set up WinControl to automatically terminate certain programs before shut down. This is a good way of getting rid of programs that need to be closed before shut down.

Start the selected action. Verify if you wish to run the programs and clear user trails before continuing.

Stop the countdown or cancel the current action, but keep this window open.

List of actions (also in the context menu). Add and remove actions with the buttons on the left.

Select one of the possible actions to be added to the list.

Remove the selected action from the list.

Move the selected action up one line.

Move the selected action down one line.

Reset all list items to factory defaults. This will add all possible entries to the list and the right-click menu.

If you wish the programs to run before logging off enable this option. Hold CTRL while starting an action to disable this option.

If you wish to cover your tracks in Windows enable this option. 12Ghosts ShutDown will then launch 12Wash before logging of and clear settings as selected in 12Wash. Hold CTRL while starting an action to disable this option.

Change ShutDown options.

Set the default action that will start when you press the hotkey or click on the tray icon.

Priority of processor time. WARNING: A priority above normal might freeze your system!

Show previous timer

Save changes and re-check all timers.

Click on the moon to animate it, click next to it to stop the animation. The mouse distance is proportional to the speed.

Change sound.

Set sound to default.

The timer will not be started after this time. A recurring timer will be deactivated after this time.

Set to start time.

Save the current timer settings as a template for new timers. The start time will be set to NOW plus an offset you can change in the Timer Defaults.

Add sample timers.

Display more/less options.

Clear entries in the list that will appear when you press START - Run and drop-down the "Open:" list. Note, you need to logoff and back on for the list to be cleared.

Remove all entries in the START - Documents menu.

Important: The recent document entries are stored twice, once in the Recent folder, and a second time in the registry. If you use the Taskbar properties to clear the Documents Menu **only**, then the folder is cleared. 12Wash will also clear the traces in the registry!

Clear the drop-down list "Named:" in the "Find Files or Folders" dialog box. You can access Find by clicking on START - Find - Files or Folders.

Clear the drop-down list "Named:" in the "Find Computer" dialog box. You can access Find Computer by clicking on START - Find - Computer.

Clear the list of Internet addresses which appear when you open the address drop-down list in Internet Explorer.

Clear the TEMP folder. This is a temporary folder used by many applications. Note: It is not recommended to clear the temporary folder while applications are running!

Windows allows you to change the location of the TEMP folder, either in the autoexec.bat (Win95/98) or by START - Settings - Control Panel - System - Environment (NT/2000).

Click on the button "Clear Selected Items Now" to start washing your trails and removing temporary files.

12Wash also supports the following command line options:

/washall Clear all selected items. This will ask you for confirmation before "washing".
/silent No warning, use in conjunction with /washall.
