Set date and time created, modified, and accessed on files and folders.

SetFileDate is an easy to use tool to set the date and time created, modified, and last accessed to single files as well as complete folders and subfolders. The graphical interface displays and lets you change the dates and times with an optimized date-time control. Full command line support!

New in this version

- You can now run SetFileDate from the command line and change one of the dates only. Instead of /time: use /created: or /modified: or /accessed:.
- New parameter "/noerrors". This will continue on all errors and messages even if the time was not set.
- SetFileDate now has it's own **General** Options, setup, help and language file.

Features of SetFileDate

Set date and time created, last modified, and last accessed, or all at once!

- Set date on single files or on all files in a folder at once, including subfolders
- Special date-time control to select quickly a date and time, up to the millisecond.
- Command line support: Automate your software publishing!
- Specify any date and time combination
- Compatible with all Windows files systems

Why should I change the file date?

- · Make your work look great!
- Mask the time you really created your documents
- · Hide when you last accessed files
- · Memorize a certain date/time
- Indicate the version number in the file time
- · For publishing software and documents
- Automate via shortcut or batch file

Command Line Options

Specify the path and the date and time on the command line of a shortcut or batch file. The /time: parameter needs to include the zeros, for example, specify "08" for August, not just "8", and so on. Use 24-hour format, that is, 18.00 instead of 6:00 pm. You can add "/subfolders" to include all subfolders of the specified folder path. Add "/silent" not to be asked for confirmation or /noerrors for no messages at all.

12filedate.exe "file-or-folder-path" /time:yyyy/MM/dd_HH:mm:ss /silent /subfolders /noerrors

/time: Date and time. All fields must exist, use "08" not just "8" for August, and

"2000" not just "00". HH is always 24-hour format, use 18:00 instead of

6:00 pm.

/subfolders Include subfolders.

/silent No confirmation message.

/noerrors No error messages even if no times are changed.
