

Overview

Since Windows 95 is coming with an easy-to-use taskbar there is no more use for the old SpeedStarter. SpeedStarter now resides in the most left corner of the taskbar and lets you easily launch your programs.

When starting the first time, SpeedStarter creates a folder called **StartData**. SpeedStarter uses this folder to manage your programs. SpeedStarter will display any shortcut placed in this folder in the most left corner of the taskbar. You can run any program managed by the SpeedStarter by double-clicking its icon. If you click with the right mouse button in SpeedStarter's screen area a small menu appears. Select **Close** to terminate SpeedStarter, **Customize** to edit items or **Run** to run a certain program.
