

# Time Adjuster FAQ

ENGLISH VERSION

## Q1: what does TPOS mean ?

*TPOS* it's unit common used in Time Adjuster. It's short-name for: Tenth Part Of Second. Other words [1TPOS it's time equal to 1/10 of second](#). That means also: 10 *TPOS'es* it's ONE SECOND & for example 0.5 of *TPOS* it's 1/20 of SECOND.

TPOS'es are used as internal Time Adjuster format and it's base unit also for MPL2 time format.

## Q2: FPS value - what is it ?

[FPS it's short-name for Frames Per Second](#). As you know every video file is made of frames. DivX movies are not an exception. But there is one problem: people who make DivX movies like to set FPS value on different level. Some movies are encoded with 25.0 frames shown per second some 23.something, ect...

What it means for YOU & why TA asks for that value ?

I made TA to ask you for FPS value only if it's REALLY necessary. The problems occurs when for example you load subtitle file written in FRAME format & want to convert it into f/e: MPL2 Time format. In source file there is only information such:

at frame 1000 show subtitle until frame 1025 ect...

and without information how to translate frames into seconds (time) such conversion is not possible. That's the job for FPS value.

Once again: [FPS = 25.0 means that during watching one second of DivX movie you will see 25 frames](#). When TA have this value conversion is possible.

## Q3: FPS value - how to get it ?

I understand that not everyone is fast enough to count number of frames per second only by watching DivX movie ;-D

That's why TA can help you & extract this value for video file. All you have to do is to select "AVI info" button and load your DivX.

Even more - if you're converting subtitle file and FPS value is required -> use "Load FPS from AVI" button, load AVI file and finally select "OK" button. FPS field will be auto-filled by movie FPS.

## Q4: Does TA support UNICODE (wide chars) ?

[No, Time Adjuster don't support UNICODE](#). I know that this is bad news for some ppl living in for example Japan. China ect....

Why ? Hmm... I really don't have enough time to do all improvements in TA I could do. And I have to make a choices – new features, help files, www page or UNICODE. And UNICODE loses ☹

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
