

Macintosh PC Exchange 2.0

Now you can move files back and forth between your Apple[™] Macintosh[™] personal computer and an IBM or compatible personal computer as easily as you can between two Macintosh systems.


Macintosh PC Exchange[™] is a time saving software utility for those who work in a mixed platform environment or need to exchange data files with people who use MS-DOS[®] or Windows[™] systems.

With Macintosh PC Exchange, you can work with other disks in the same way you do with Macintosh disks. Just insert an MS-DOS, Windows or OS/2 formatted disk into your Macintosh system; Macintosh PC Exchange immediately displays the disk's icon on your desktop. The disk's contents appear as documents and folders that you can open, save, rename, move, copy and delete — just like Macintosh files. It's just as easy to move files from your Macintosh to an IBM compatible computer. Simply insert an MS-DOS formatted disk into your system or let the Macintosh format one for you — and drag the files onto it. Then take the disk to a PC and begin working. It's that simple.

Now with Macintosh PC Exchange 2.0, in addition to floppy disks you can work with SCSI hard disks formatted under the MS-DOS, Windows or OS/2 operating system, as well as with floptical, Bernoulli and SyQuest removable media devices.

You can also customise Macintosh PC Exchange to automatically launch your favourite Macintosh applications when you double click on MS-DOS or Windows data files. For example, it can launch Lotus 1-2-3 for the Macintosh when you click on a file created using Lotus 1-2-3 for Windows.
