## **4.1.1** Pro (June 2, 1997)

• Fixed a bug that caused the bottom of the Print Preview... dialog box to disappear on small monitors.

## **4.1** Pro (June 1, 1997)

- Added support for high resolution pictures. This means that you can now add PICT files of any dpi, to take full advantage of your printer's maximum print quality.
- Memory requirements have been drastically reduced. The CD Label Printer Pro no longer uses off-screen buffering for pictures, so adding 24-bit color, 600 dpi PICT files will no longer cause any memory errors.
- Added an option to print both front and back labels on one page, instead of two.
- Fixed a bug that caused unnecessary screen redraws in the print preview screen.
- Added a detailed help window to answer commonly asked questions.
- Changed the label file format to accommodate high resolution graphics. Label files from earlier versions of the CD Label Printer Pro (4.0 4.0.3) are automatically converted to the new format upon opening them. However, if you wish to take advantage of the new high resolution graphics feature, you will need to add new high resolution pictures to your labels.

## 4.0.3 Pro (April 12, 1997)

- Fixed a bug that prevented 16-bit and 24-bit color images from printing at maximum quality.
- Added more error checking during printing.
- Added a check to make the label printer WindowShade saavy.
- Included the AspenMall Registration application.

## 4.0.2 Pro (March 18, 1997)

- Files opened by double-clicking on them in the finder now save correctly.
- Fixed a printing bug introduced in version 4.0.1 that was caused by saving the Page Setup.../Print... dialog settings. These settings are no longer saved in the application, as this caused numerous printing problems for many registered users.

## 4.0.1 Pro (March 7, 1997)

- Fixed memory leak that could cause crashes with large files.
- Fixed title text so it no longer flashes after the front label or back label tabs are clicked.
- Preview now defaults to label that is currently visible in the window. Previously, the back label would be selected by default in the preview window even if the front label was currently selected.
- Preview now looks exactly like the printed page, not the screen.
- Page Setup.../Print... dialog settings are now saved in the application, so they no longer need to be reset each time.

#### 4.0 Pro (February 1, 1997)

- Added font, color, style, justification, and size control for the front and back labels.
- Added improved layout options for better graphics placement, on both front and back labels.
- Previews of of both front and back Labels now shown.
- Removed the "Music CD" format because the new generic label format can serve to make any type of label.
- Removed the "CD Label Printer Pro" credit from the bottom of the label.

# 3.0.1 Pro (January 14, 1997)

• Fixed a printing bug with some printer drivers that failed to print.

- Included a Netscape Bookmark to the registration web site.
- Removed the term 'Netware' from the product to avoid a legal conflict with Novell.

## 3.0 Pro (December 1, 1996)

- Signed up AspenMall as the distributor for this program.
- Added support for the front label.
- Added crop marks to aid in cutting out the labels.
- Fixed another printer scaling bug.
- Replaced the status message at the bottom of the label with a more concise notice.

- Fixed bug that caused system beeps on file saves.
