# Setting Up the Port Trigger List

### About the Port Trigger List

Provided is an example of what the Port Trigger List looks like and how to set it up. After you have selected the Port Juggler icon, you will see the "Which port is the Port Juggler connected to?" splash screen. Once you have choosen a port and selected OK you will see a blank Port trigger List on the right side of the Chooser. Select a Port Juggler port from the "Port" menu and then assign your device to it, from the "Devices" menu. Once, you have assigned all your devices you will need to shutdown your Mac and configure your hardware to match the Port Trigger List you just created.

There are two popup menus located on the bottom of the right side of the Chooser. The first menu is the "Port" menu. This port tells the Port Juggler which ports your devices are connected to. You have a choice of "1, 2, 3 or 4".
