Background
The
Lhad
Sector,
in
all
respects,
is
a
backwater.
Until
recently,
the
Alliance
has
only
taken
the
most
marginal
of
interests
in
this
area
of
the
Galaxy.
One
system,
Grym
A,
is
moderately
inhabited,
and
provides
a
small
industrial
and
agricultural
output,
enough
that
it
produces
a
fair
amount
of
export
used

for
our
services.
The
Empire
has
taken
little
notice
of
this
sector,
as
well.
Much
of
the
area
away
from
Grym
A
has
been
charted,
but
not
explored
or
surveyed
within
recent
memory.
Nonaligned
interest
is
similarly
low;
there's
simply
not
that
much
out
there.
Recent
events,
however,
have
drastically
changed
the
Alliances'
attitude
toward
the
sleepy
sector.
Several
months
ago,
a
heretofore
unknown

Library,
based
in
the
Cytrelloe
system,
began
a
huge
data
dump
into
open
comm
lines.
Built
before
the
Clone
Wars,
no
one
is
sure
why
this
automated
action
occured,
but
the
result
was
that
we
suddenly
gained
a
huge
amount
of
information
thought
lost.
Most
of
the
data
was
garbled
or
fragmentary,
and
unfortunately,
the
Cytrelloe
Library
went
through
a
complete
(and
irrevocable)
shutdown

after
its
transmission.
As
you
probably
already
expect,
new
information
came
to
light
about
Sectors
and
the
Systems
they
contained.
Lhad
drew
great
interest
because
of
one
particular
System:
Ggollek
(pronounced
GOAL-
lek)
. Built
long
before
the
Clone
Wars,
the
information
showed
this
system
to
be
an
industrial
powerhouse.
Analysis
revealed
that,
at
full
output,
Ggollek's
industrial
output
matched
nearly
25%
of
the

Alliances'
total
current
capability.
A
rich
prize
indeed.
. .
one
worth
investigating
immediately.
This
investigation
is
even
more
urgent
in
that
the
data
exhumed
from
the
Library
also
reached
Imperial
ears,
and
they,
too,
would
also
desire
the
Ggollek
System's
treasure.
Operation
Header
Fist
was
quickly
created.
As
most
of
our
squadrons
are
assigned
on
important
assignments
elsewhere,
the
reserves
have
been
called

into
action
to
meet
the
Operation's
goals.
7th
Tactical
Starfighter
Wing,
Blue
Squadron,
has
been
deployed
to
Grym
A's
main
starport,
Ellison.
Conditions
are
crowded,
but
sufficient.
Blue
Squadron
must
work
quickly
and
efficiently
to
secure
Ggollek,
and,
if
it
is
still
of
use,
to
defend
it
if
necessary.
Phase
One:
Establish
Perimeter
at
Dystrasha
EpsilonThe
first
goal
of
Operation
Header
Fist
is
to

extend
a
defensive
and
information-
gathering
perimeter
in
the
Dystrasha
Epsilon
system.
If
Imperial
involvement
is
imminent,
or
already
present,
it
is
important
that
we
move
the
fight
away
from
Grym
A.
Secondly,
this
forward
position
will
allow
us
to
keep
a
closer
eye
on
Ggollek.
Dystrasha
Epsilon
is
the
perfect
place.
The
system
consists
only
of
its
red
supergiant,
and
the
immense
Oort

cloud
characteristic
of
such
stars.
The
Oort
cloud
provides
ready
concealment
for
Early
Warning
sensors
and
long-
range
probes,
as
well
as
forward
supply
depots.
While
the
Prong
star
systems
will
be
unsurveyed,
they
are
easily
scanned
from
Grym
A
(unlike
Dystrasha
Epsilon,
another
side
effect
of
red
supergiants)
.
