

Documentation Changes

In case you received older versions of the printed documentation, please note the following corrections:

1. Silverlining Lite has replaced Silver Volumes and Silver Control. Silverlining Lite is a program which provides essential Macintosh drive management functions in a convenient control panel. Use Silverlining Lite to quickly mount and unmount volumes, change SCSI polling preferences, format drives, and erase volumes.

See the documentation file "Silverlining® Lite Read Me" for instructions to use the Control Panel. (Printings of the La Cie Storage Utilities User's Guide and Silverlining User's Guide prior to September 1995 don't include Silverlining Lite instructions.)

Be sure to remove all copies of Silver Volumes and Silver Control from the System Folder of your startup drive before installing Silverlining Lite.

2. SilverLauncher has replaced the "ReadMe" file. SilverLauncher is an application that lets you open Silverlining or Disk First Aid, or restart or shut down the Macintosh when starting up from a Silverlining Startup Disk.

Use "SilverLauncher" instead of "ReadMe" when creating your Silverlining Startup Disk as described below. (Printings of the La Cie Storage Utilities User's Guide, Silverlining User's Guide, or Getting Started Brochure prior to September 1995 refer to the "ReadMe" File.)
