PANTONE Color Support for the EPSON Stylus COLOR 3000, 1520, and 800 Printers

Specially calibrated PANTONE color palette files and a calibrated color table are now available for the EPSON Stylus COLOR 3000, 1520, and 800 printers. The files and table from PANTONE provide custom CMYK (cyan, magenta, yellow, and black) color combinations for creating facsimiles of every color in the PANTONE COLOR MATCHING SYSTEM (except for specialty colors, such as metallic, fluorescent, and double-impression colors).

You can load the PANTONE color table as a color palette in most PANTONE-licensed application programs. Make sure to print using the palette files **only** on your EPSON Stylus COLOR 3000, 1520, or 800 printer when you've loaded coated and glossy ink jet paper and are printing at 720 dpi. If you're printing color separations or preparing files for printing by your Service Bureau, you need to recreate the colors in your graphics files using the PANTONE color tables that came with your PANTONE-licensed application.

Every attempt is made to accurately match color values as closely as possible to the PANTONE spot colors. However, no color matching scheme can guarantee an exact match, due to environmental and other characteristics that affect how we perceive color. For example, a color that appears to be an exact match under incandescent room lighting may appear differently under fluorescent lighting conditions. While many of these factors are accounted for in the process of developing the colors, an exact match is not possible under all visual conditions.
