The Article Palette

Using the Article Palette, you can assign an article name to text or picture boxes and change their position within the article. For the currently selected box, the palette shows its article name and its position within the article. Text boxes that are linked together always belong to the same article and share the same position number.

To assign an article to a box, select the box and enter the article name into the palette. If the article already exists, you can also select its name from the popup menu. The Article Menu contains two special names: "Untitled" and "No Article". Boxes that have not been assigned an article are "Untitled". An option in the Article-XT Settings Dialog specifies, whether article information should be created for untitled text boxes. A box with the name "No Article" does not belong to any article and no article information is created for it. For picture boxes, "Untitled" means the same as "No Article".

To change the position of a box within its article, select the new position from the Position Menu. The other boxes in the article change their positions accordingly.

Located on the right-hand side of the Article Palette is the Command Menu, that lets you open the Article Usage Window, the Article-XT Settings Dialog and the Online Help.
