

Purchasing our product provides you with a base of calligraphic brushes or pens for your favorite illustration package. An illustration package needs thousands of Calligraphic Pens to allow more variables in the artwork or illustration being creatively produced. Furthermore, with a large library of pens changes to drawings can be made quickly without the hassle of making new brush sets from scratch.

Installation (using two different methods)

Illustrator brushes or pallets are stored inside the Brush Libraries folder or may be installed while Illustrator is running. The illustration below displays where to install brushes if you want Illustrator to recognize the brush strokes upon startup. Please see the tutorial before installing a large number of brushes in this folder.



Installation Method 1 (Installation using the "Brush Library" folder)

Installing brushes inside the Brush Libraries folder enables Illustrator to display your calligraphic pens within pallets and enables you to choose brush sets from a menu. Within Illustrator select "window" and scroll down to Brush Libraries. Your menu should look similar to the menu below. Depending on the number of brushes already installed your screen may look a little different.


Installation Method 2 (Installation using "Other Library")

If the Illustrator application is running you can import pallets or brush sets by selecting the "Other Library" option under Illustrator's window menu. Selecting "Other Library" will open a dialog box allowing you to choose a path to the brush set. Installing brush sets in this manner reduces the size of the menu considering Illustrator will not look for brush sets outside of the Brush Libraries folder when starting up.

Installation Method 2 (using "Other Library" cont.)

If you use the dialog box method the dialog box below may look familiar. Just remember you are selecting a library to use so you must route a path to the specific HannahWare Volume.



Scroll Down and select the following folder or a brush folder set you desire to use. If you select the folder with the name "The 25's" you will be selecting calligraphic pens with a 25 degree angle. The highlighted brush below has a 25 degree angle and a roundness of 75%.

Installation Method 2 (using "Other Library" cont.)

Illustrator should import the file and draw a pallet that you can use for making strokes. If you chose the same file used in the previous steps your pallet should look similar to the one below. Add as many pallets as you desire using this method to achieve the result your looking for. If you ever decide that there are a particular sets of brushes or pens you use often then it is beneficial to put them in the Brush Library folder so they will launch when Illustrator starts. As you may already know the tabs on the pallet below are movable so you can mix and match your brush sets. In the pallet below there are three different brush sets to give you an idea of the possibilities.



Your HannaWare Volume contains many pen or brush sizes which save you the headache of making a multitiude of brushes from scratch. It is not possible to include all variations of a brush or pen so you may need to adjust the settings of a particular brush. If you need to change the characteristics of a pen or brush use the following steps.

Drag the item you want to change from the Cal Pen pallet to the "Brushes " pallette.






Making Changes to the provided strokes brushes or pens (cont.)

Draging and droping a selected pen or brush from a HannahWare set to the brushes pallet allows for creating a new brushes. Once a HannahWare pen is placed in the brushes pallet it becomes a brush or pen that may be edited. By double clicking on a new brush a dialog box similar to the screen shot below will pops up. Within this dialog you may change any of the variables not included with the original HannaWare set.

File Management (Do's Dont's & Info)

Allowing all of your brushes to reside on your hard drive will take approximately 40-60MB of space. Please have the respective amount of space available before unstuffing your product.

Do's....

Try to keep all your brushes available for quick access.

Back up your brushes as a compressed file.

Call or E-mail us if you have any difficulties.

Dont's...

Try not to keep a large number of brushes in the brush libraries folder. Large numbers of brushes in this folder will increase the menu size. You will be able to narrow down particular or favorite brush sizes to use in production. Once you have found your favorite sizes place them in the brush libraries folder. You will then be able to access those brushes quickly.
