

PrintRGB QuarkXTensions™ software enables QuarkXPress™ or QuarkXPress Passport™ to output composite RGB TIFF image files without converting them to the CMYK color model.

You can print RGB TIFFs from QuarkXPress without this XTensions™ module. Please consult the “Using PrintRGB” section to determine if it is appropriate for you to use PrintRGB.

Minimum System Requirements

Mac OS

Software

- QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport 4.0
- Mac OS 7.1.2

Windows

Software

- QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport 4.0
- Microsoft Windows 95/98, or Windows NT 3.51 or 4.0

Installation Instructions for Mac OS


- 1** Quit QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport.
- 2** Copy the PrintRGB file into the XTension folder within your QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport folder.
- 3** Relaunch QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport.

Installation Instructions for Windows

- 1 Quit QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport.
- 2 Copy the PrintRGB.XNT file into the XTension folder within your QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport folder.
- 3 Relaunch QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport.

Using PrintRGB

When PrintRGB is loaded, QuarkXPress outputs all RGB TIFF image files without converting them to the CMYK color model; this allows your output device to perform the conversion. PrintRGB will not affect CMYK TIFFs, colored QuarkXPress page items, or text.

 You must remove PrintRGB from your XTension folder to disable it; the XTensions Manager (**Utilities** → **XTensions Manager**) cannot disable PrintRGB.

You should use PrintRGB if:

- You print composite color output that contains RGB TIFFs (either to a printer, a PostScript file, or a PDF)

and

- You prefer that your output device, rather than QuarkXPress, handles the conversion of RGB images to the CMYK color model.

You should not use PrintRGB if:

- You do not output RGB TIFF files
- You are satisfied with the current output of your RGB TIFFs
- You output RGB TIFFs, but only to separations
- You use QuarkCMS QuarkXTensions software for color matching.

Note: QuarkCMS is designed to work with CMYK profiles.
