



# Quick, How do I Make a Banner?

1) Double clicking on the Banner Maker icon, you will be presented with a dialog containg the default banner text.



2) Enter the text you want on your banner and click OK.




3) A window containg your banner will appear




4) Change the font and style if you wish using the pull down menus.




5) Choose Save from the **File** menu and save your banner. It is always a good idea to save your work before you print.






6) Choose Page Setup from the **File** menu and insure that Landscape (sideways) printing and no gaps between pages are selected as shown below.



7) Choose Print from the **File** menu and click Print.



8) Go get a pizza, banners take lots of time to print.

Banner Maker: Printing software for the Apple Macintosh

#### What is Banner Maker?

Banner Makers is a full featured banner printing application for the Apple Macintosh.

#### Features:

- 1) Prints very large banners using both ATM<sup>TM</sup> and TrueType<sup>TM</sup> outline fonts.
- 2) Floating text allows for great text effects
- 3) Supports inport of graphics via the clipboard.
- 4) Alignment of graphic objects.
- 5) Save banners for reuse at a later date.

#### The Banner Maker Window.

Below is a picture a Banner Maker window. Please note the landscape/protrait indicator. This indicator is designed to show you the orientation you have selected in the Page Setup dialog. Normaly you will want to print in landscape mode (shown) if a question mark appears in this area, your printer driver can not tell Banner Maker which mode you have selected in the Page Setup Dialog.



Within the window you should also notice the light gray lines, these lines show you where the pages break on the banner. As you move items in the banner, you may notice that the number of pages the banner contains is automaticly updated for you.

# **Text**

#### **Entering Text onto the banner:**

There are two kinds of text allowed on a banner, fixed text and floating text.

Fixed text is thought of as the background text. Normaly fixed text is the very large part of the banner. When you select New from the **File** menu, you are prompted for the fixed text.



The number of lines of fixed text is limited by the font size currently selected. With 120 point text, three lines of text will fit nicely on a horizontal ImageWriter page. 240 point allows for two lines of text, and 480 for only one line of fixed text. (The appendix has some interesting information about changing these values)

The term Fixed Text must be used loosely however. The text is fixed in that you canNOT make any adjustments to its size or placement that are not found in the pulldown menus.

Floating text, on the other hand, moves around on the screen just like any picture in MacDraw<sup>TM</sup>. To enter new floating text choose New Floating Text from the **Edit** menu. This text may be moved and resized just like a picture in most drawing programs. Using this feature you can get some very interesting effects.

Floating text is placed onto the banner using the current Size, Font and Style selection in the MenuBar. Once a piece of floating text is created, its font and style can be changed by selecting the text item and choosing the appropriate menus. The size can be changed by dragging the handles of selected floating text.

# **Graphics**

#### **Pasting Graphics onto the Banner**

After copying a picture onto the clipboard from another application or desk accessory, you can choose Paste from the **Edit** menu Each pasted graphic will appear either at the last "mouse click" location or in the upper left hand corner of the banner window.


#### **Changing Picture Sizes**

Notice the eight handles (blocks) surrounding the picture below. You can change the size of any picture or floating text you have pasted onto the banner by dragging any one of these handles.




If after resizeing an object if you want to return it to its original size, hold down the command key (業) while clicking once on any handle.

Using both command key and option and command keys, click on any handle and you can resize pictures by percentage. The percentage choosen must be an integer in the range of 10% to 1000%.

## File Menu:

New Clears old banner from the screen and starts a new banner.

Open Open a previously saved banner.

----

Save Saves the banner you are currently working on to disk

Save As Save the banner you are currently working on to disk using a user supplied name.


----

Page Setup Tells banner maker how you would like the banner to appear on paper. The best setting for the ImageWriter is Sideways, no gaps between pages.

Print Sends the banner to the printer. To cancel printing, click the cancel button. Printing will occur in the background if you are running Multi-finder.

Quit Leave Banner Maker.



#### **Edit Menu:**

Undo Here only for DA's, I don't have undo working yet.

----

Cut Copies the currently selected picture to the clipboard and deletes it from the

banner.

Copy Copies the currently selected picture to the clipboard.

Paste Places the contents of the clipboard onto the banner. Text is converted to a

picture. (You're going to LOVE this)

Clear Delete pictures from the banner (same as backspace key)

----

Duplicate Makes a copy of the selected picture(s) onto the banner. This is a quick copy

and paste.

Select All This is a quick way of selecting every picture on the banner.

----

Align Pictures Align the selected pictures in relation to each other.

----

Edit Banner Text Edit the master banner text.

New Floating Text Enters new text onto the banner in a MacDraw like picture. The current font

and style are used.



## **Font Menu:**

Use this menu to select the current banner font. This effects the font for all of the lines of fixed text in the banner. Existing floating text is not effected by a font change. New floating text will be created with whatever font is currently selected.



#### Size Menu:

The Size menu is used to change the size of fixed banner text. Use this menu to select the current banner font size. If you would like to create text in a size other than those in the menu, you'll need to use floating text.

The number of banner lines is automaticaly adjusted by the size you pick.


#### 120 - Three lines of text




#### 240 - Two lines of text

## **Style Menu:**

Plain Removes all styles

----

Bold Toggles the bold style

Italic Toggles the italic style

Underline Toggles the underline style

Outline Toggles the outline style

Shadow Toggles the shadow style

Condensed Toggles the condensed sytle (tighten up the characters)

Extended Toggles the extended sytle (allow extra space between characters)

Left Justify All lines of the banner will be flush left

Right Justify All lines of the banner will be right flush

Center Justify All lines of the banner will be centered on the banner pages

# Appendix A

## Tricks of the Trade

#### **Fonts**

This software is designed to work only with outline fonts. If the screen display looks nasty, you probably shouldn't expect "good things" to happen! Both ATM and True Type fonts work great!

#### Changing the defaults. (requires ResEdit knowledge!!!)

The default font, size and style of the banner maker is stored as a resource in the program itself. With a copy of resedit you can copy the FINT (font information) resource from any of your saved banners and paste it directly inside the Banner program.

The default strings are stored as resources STR 1024, 1025 and 1026 and may be changed as well.

By editing the MENU resources in the size menu, you can make "neat things" happen.

#### Changing the size menu

If you want to print banners with different sizes of fixed text, you can edit the size menu using ResEdit from Apple Computer. The first three items in the menu control the number of fixed text lines allowed on the banner.

#### Printing BIG banners.

If you used ATM:

The more RAM you have for ATM, the better this sofware will work! On a One Meg MacPlus, you can play a nice game of RISK<sup>TM</sup> by the time a three page banner prints. But if you have Four Meg of RAM in the same machine, and dedicate 1 meg to ATM, the same banner will print in 1/10 the time. In short, give ATM as much RAM as you can spare!

If you use TrueType (System 6.0.x requires an INIT, System 7.x has TrueType built in): TrueType shares memory with the rest of the system. The more free memory available, the faster banners will print.
