

A/S can print in two different ways. It can print a report that lists most of the current file processing settings and, if it has not been personalized, it can also print a registration form which can be filled out and sent to the author.

Choose the Print Items... menu item to open the Printing Preferences window. This window is used to control which processing settings are included when printing settings.

The processing settings printout should be fairly self-explanatory. Editable character strings are enclosed by quotation marks. Disabled Replacement Strings have "(off)" added after them. Replacement Strings that ignore case have "(ic)" added after them. For the most part, the processing settings are listed in the order in which A/S performs its processing.

Choose the Page Setup... menu item to adjust paper size, orientation, and other printing options.
