Introducing Norton WinDoctor

Norton WinDoctor is the safe and easy way to diagnose and repair the most common types of Windows problems. It checks all the information necessary for Windows to run properly. Plus it checks for components needed by programs that run under Windows.

Norton WinDoctor starts with a Wizard interface to let you choose the kinds of diagnostic tests you want to perform. After running the tests, Norton WinDoctor displays an easy-to-read report of the problems it has found. Problems are listed by problem type in the order of severity. You can choose to display the list sorted by name or status (whether they are fixed).

Norton WinDoctor lets you tailor the repair process to your own needs. You can specify which problems to fix and how to fix them. Or, you can let Norton WinDoctor fix all found problems automatically.

If you decide you don't like a repair WinDoctor has made, undo it. To undo repairs you made in previous sessions, use Norton WinDoctor's Repair History feature.

Norton WinDoctor keeps Windows running at peak efficiency. This not only makes using your computer faster and easier, but also safer. By fixing errors that might otherwise lead to data loss, Norton WinDoctor protects your work.

Combined with Norton System Doctor, Norton WinDoctor is even more effective. Norton System Doctor can automatically monitor your computer for Windows problems. If a problem arises, Norton System Doctor informs you of it and lets you launch Norton WinDoctor to correct the problem.

About problem types

Norton WinDoctor detects and corrects a wide variety of Windows problems. You don't need to know anything about the problems that are being repaired. Norton WinDoctor automatically repairs the problems using the best possible solution.

However, if you want to become more involved in the repair process, Norton WinDoctor also lets you pick and choose what problems to correct and how to repair them. Problems you may encounter while scanning your computer with Norton WinDoctor include:

Missing program files

One or more of the files necessary to run one of your programs is missing.

ActiveX/COM related problems

A registry entry that points to a component required for one or more of your programs is invalid.

Invalid shortcuts

One or more of the shortcuts to programs is invalid.

Registry related problems

For example, orphaned shortcuts where one or more entries in the registry refer to files that do not exist.

About ignoring problems using Analysis Agents

Norton WinDoctor is designed to provide the most thorough scanning possible for Windows problems. Many irrelevant problems are removed by Norton WinDoctor Analysis Agents, but you still might encounter problems you feel are unimportant.

You can keep problems you choose not to fix from repeatedly displaying in Problems Found by choosing to ignore them in the Select Analysis Agents dialog box. Once they are marked as ignored, the problems no longer display.

To get to the Select Analysis Agents dialog box, select Let Me Choose Which Tests to Run on the first panel of the Norton WinDoctor Wizard.

If you later decide that you want to see or fix problems you previously ignored, you can clear the ignored problems list in the Options dialog. All ignored problems display in the Details view.

About undoing Norton WinDoctor repairs

By default, Norton WinDoctor always asks you to confirm before it makes a repair. Even with this extra safeguard, you may sometimes want to undo a repair. With Norton WinDoctor, not only can you undo a repair you just made, but you can also undo a repair you made yesterday or even last week.

The Repair History tracks the changes that Norton WinDoctor makes to your system. To undo any tracked repair, open the Repair History screen, click to select a repair, and then click the Undo button on the toolbar.

• To configure how long or how many Repair History items are retained, open the View menu and choose Options.

Types of Norton WinDoctor repairs

Norton WinDoctor checks your computer for all kinds of Windows problems, including problems that pertain to:

- Shortcuts
- ActiveX/Com
- Application paths
- Our Contract of the Contrac
- System configuration settings
- Fonts
- File dependencies
- System startup settings
- DOS program configuration files

If you suspect a certain type of problem, you can choose to limit Norton WinDoctor to one or more specific problem types with the Norton WinDoctor wizard. Most of the time however, you'll want to do a full scan to keep your computer running at its best.

About alternate repair methods

When Norton WinDoctor detects a problem, it suggests a recommended repair method. This is generally the best and most complete solution to the problem. If you wish, you can also select from a list of alternate repair methods. These alternate methods also correct the problem, but in a different way. Most of the time, you'll want to select the recommended solution.

The Problems Found pane lists high-level problem types, which can include one or more individual problems. To see a complete list of problems, click Details.

Selecting Norton WinDoctor Analysis Agents

Norton WinDoctor automatically filters out certain types of irrelevant problem conditions. For instance, some of the tests that make perfect sense to run on your hard disk would not apply to a removable drive, such as a Zip drive. To avoid cluttering the test results with irrelevant information, Norton WinDoctor uses a series of Analysis Agents to omit this information. You can turn these Analysis Agents off and on to suit any special conditions you may encounter.

Click any checkbox to uncheck it, disabling that Analysis Agent. When all of the options are disabled, all problems encountered by WinDoctor are reported, regardless of relevance.

Selecting Norton WinDoctor scans

Norton WinDoctor can perform a variety of scans to find problems with your system. You may not wish to run every scan every time you run Norton WinDoctor. This dialog box displays the list of available scans and allows you to select the ones you want Norton WinDoctor to run.

This dialog box contains the following:

Norton WinDoctor scan checkbox list

Click any checkbox to uncheck it, disabling that scan.

To see information about each scan, place your cursor over it and read the tooltip that displays. 0 Deselect all/Select all

Deselects or selects all the available scans.

Analysis Agents

Click to open the Select Analysis Agents dialog box, where you can specify how you want Norton WinDoctor to process the problems it finds.

Automated Repair dialog box

This dialog box displays when you click Repair after selecting a problem type in the top section of the Problems Found pane. On this dialog box, you select how WinDoctor should repair the selected sub-problems included in that problem type.

Let WinDoctor Pick The Best Solution...

Click to allow WinDoctor to automatically repair each sub-problem in the selected problem type by determining the best solution and applying it.

Allow Me To Choose The Solution...

Click if you want to choose from a list of available solutions for each sub-problem. This option opens the Automated Repair dialog box.

Select Repair Solutions dialog box

The Automated Repair dialog box displays one sub-problem at a time, and presents the available solution methods to repair it. The first solution in the list is the most complete fix for the problem. You may select other solutions or accept the recommendation.

This dialog box contains the following:

Select Solution list

Select the solution you want applied to the problem.

Repair

Click Repair to apply the selected solution.

Cancel

If you selected a problem type with multiple sub-problems, or a group of sub-problems, Cancel allows you to skip the currently displayed sub-problem and display the next, or close this dialog box.

About problem severity

Norton WinDoctor displays an easy-to-read report of the problems it found. Problems are listed by problem type in the order of severity.

There are three levels of severity:

Low

Problem that is unlikely to affect your use of the computer, but should be repaired to keep your system uncluttered. For example, you may have a reference to a file in the registry that points to a file that has been moved or deleted.

Medium

Problem that would be an annoyance to you, but probably won't interfere with the most important tasks you perform. For example, if an application shortcut refers to a file that is missing or has been moved, you would not be able to launch that application from the shortcut.

High

Problem that can block you from using your computer or could result in data loss. For example, if a file that is required to run an application is missing or corrupt.

Welcome

Welcome to Norton WinDoctor, the safe and easy way to diagnose and repair the most common types of Windows problems. You can tailor the repair process to your own needs, by selecting which tests to run and which problems to fix.

After running the tests, Norton WinDoctor displays an easy-to-read report of the problems it found. You can specify which problems to fix and how to fix them. Or, you can let Norton WinDoctor fix all found problems automatically.

Select one option, then click Next to continue.

Perform all Norton WinDoctor tests (recommended)

Runs all the available Norton WinDoctor tests.

Opens the scan checkbox list where you can select specific tests to run.

Wait for all the scans to be completed, then click Next to see the results.

Stop

Click to stop Norton WinDoctor activity.

Finish

Norton WinDoctor presents its findings on this dialog.

Click to repair the selected problem.

Displays the name of the currently selected problem.

Click the box to apply this repair solution to the rest of the problems in this group.

Click this option to choose the solution method for each selected problem.

Click this option to let Norton WinDoctor automatically repair all selected problems using its recommended method.
