To create a shortcut to a running program with Dropsy

- 1 Make sure that the application you wish to create a shortcut to is running.
- 2 Left click on the Dropsy taskbar icon. Alternately, right-click the Dropsy taskbar icon, then click Grasp and Drag.
- 3 Click the wand cursor on the window you wish to 'grasp'.
- 4 Hold down the mouse button and drag the mouse cursor to where you wish to create the shortcut, for example, the Start menu.

Tip

- **o** Dropsy can also be used to drag applications from their windows to other applications that support drag and drop, such as iconbars, resource editors, and so forth.
- **o** If after clicking on the Dropsy icon, you decide not to grasp an application, click either on the Dropsy icon or the desktop to dismiss the wand cursor.

Example of Grasp and Drag

This example will take you step by step through how to add Notepad to your Start menu with Dropsy.

- Double-click the Dropsy tray icon. In the Run dialog box that appear, type 'notepad' and press return.
- 2 Left click on the Dropsy tray icon. The tray icon will change colors, and the cursor will change to a wand, indicating that you can now click on a window to 'grasp' its executable.
- 3 Click on the notepad window and hold down the mouse button. Notice that the Dropsy tray icon changes colors back, and the cursor changes to a 'No Drop' cursor.
- 4 Move the mouse cursor over the start menu. Notice that it changes to an arrow with a document icon next to it, indicating that dropping here is allowed.
- 5 Release the mouse button.
- 6 Click the Start button. Notice that the topmost item is now 'Notepad'.

Other Useful Features of Dropsy

Dropsy also has a number of other useful features designed to be shortcuts to everyday Windows 95 functions:

- **o** To run a program, double-click the Dropsy icon in the taskbar tray. This is a shortcut to the Start menu's <u>Run</u> command. Alternately, right-click the Dropsy taskbar icon, then click Run.
- **o** To shutdown, restart, or log on as another user, right-click on the Dropsy icon in the taskbar tray. The menu which pops up includes menu item options to Shutdown System, Restart System, and Logoff.
- **o** To get copyright information about Dropsy, right-click on the Dropsy icon in the taskbar tray, and select the About Dropsy menu item.
