What's the purpose of this program?

This program (**MDB95**) will do several tests to measure the speed of your harddisk or CD-ROM drive under Windows 95 or Windows NT 3.51 or higher. It will write and read a test-file in pieces of 32kb.

This is shareware!

MDB95 is shareware. You are free to use it for a free trial period of up to 30 days. If you want to use this program after the free trial period you need to register it.

WARNING! If you do not register MDB95 it will stop working after the free trial period has ended. When you register you will be sent information on how to unlock MDB95.

Registration costs only 10 US\$ and can be done via the SWREG forum in CompuServe. The registration ID for **MDB95** is 6483.

Be sure to include your mailing-address or your EMail-address, so that we can send you the registration code that you need to disable the lockout after the 30-days trial period.

If you are a German resident you can send DM10,- instead of US\$10.

What you should know:

To ensure that you get valid results, you should **set the size of the test-file larger than the RAM size of your computer**. Otherwise you wouldn't measure the speed of your disk, but the speed of the disk-cache (which can also be useful).

Disk fragmentation can have a large influence on this benchmark, so in order to get optimal results, you should *run Defrag* (which under Windows 95 can be found in Start|Programs|Accessories|System Tools| Disk Defragmenter) before running this benchmark.

Another useful information is that harddisks are usually fastest at their beginning, because the outer parts of a harddisk (and these are the beginning) can contain more sectors per track.

Because of this **you should ideally run any disk-benchmark on an almost empty drive** and on the first partition if you have multiple partitions on the drive, to get the best results.

If you are testing the read-performance of your CD-ROM drive, you should select a large file (>1.5mb) on your CD for the testing.

Please note that non-cached testing is not available for the read-test (CD-Test) because the operating system only allows non-cached data transfer for files whose size is a multiple of the sector size of the harddisk/CD-ROM.

Program history:

- Fixes the problem where MDB95 reports that you don't have enough free space to run the test when you have more than 2qb free space.

Version 2.00:

- First 32-bit version of MDB95.
