QUARKXPRESS AND QUARKXPRESS PASSPORT 4.0 DEMO

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Minimum system requirements for QuarkXPress™ 4.0 and QuarkXPress Passport™ 4.0 for 68K Mac OS

- 68020 or greater processor
 - System 7.1 or later (Open Transport 1.1 or greater recommended)
 - 5MB of free RAM (7MB or greater recommended for graphic-intensive documents)
 - 13MB of free hard disk space (30MB for QuarkXPress Passport)
 - Adobe Type Manager 3.8.2 or above recommended
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Minimum system requirements for QuarkXPress 4.0 and QuarkXPress Passport 4.0 for PowerPC Mac OS

- PowerPC processor
 - System 7.1.2 or later
 - 8MB of free RAM (10MB or greater recommended for graphic-intensive documents)
 - 14MB of free hard disk space (30MB for QuarkXPress Passport)
 - Adobe Type Manager 3.8.2 or above recommended
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Minimum system requirements for QuarkXPress 4.0 and QuarkXPress Passport 4.0 for Windows

- 486 or greater processor
 - Windows 95, Windows NT 4.0, or Windows NT 3.51
 - 12MB of RAM (additional memory may be required for graphic-intensive documents)
 - 12MB of free hard disk space (30MB for QuarkXPress Passport)
 - VGA or higher resolution display adapter and monitor supported by Windows 95 or Windows NT
 - Adobe Type Manager 3.0 or above recommended (required to view and print Type 1 fonts)
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Installing QuarkXPress 4.0 or QuarkXPress Passport 4.0 for Mac OS

1. Open the QuarkXPress 4.0 Demo CD-ROM.
2. Locate the installation program for the application you wish to install (US English Demo

- Installer or Passport Demo Installer). Double-click the icon for the installation program.
3. Locate the folder in which you wish to install the demo software, then click Continue to complete the installation.
 4. Double-click the QuarkXPress Demo icon or QuarkXPress Passport Demo icon to launch the application.
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Installing QuarkXPress 4.0 or QuarkXPress Passport 4.0 for Windows

1. Insert the QuarkXPress 4.0 CD-ROM.
 2. The installation process should start automatically. If it doesn't, double-click the file Install.exe.
 3. Locate the folder in which you wish to install the Demo software.
 4. If you wish to customize the installation, click the Customize button, then select the application(s) you wish to install.
 5. Click Continue to complete the installation.
 6. Double-click the QuarkXPress Demo.exe or QuarkXPress Passport Demo.exe icon in the Program Files folder, or select the Icons from the Windows Start menu to launch the application.
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Limitations of the QuarkXPress 4.0 and QuarkXPress Passport 4.0 Demo

The QuarkXPress 4.0 demo contains the following limitations not present in the actual application:

- Files cannot be saved.
 - Printing is limited to five pages at a time.
 - All printed output contains the words "QuarkXPress Demo."
 - New libraries cannot be created.
 - Non-PostScript printing is disabled (Mac OS only).
 - Print jobs cannot be spooled; you must print directly to the printer (Windows only).
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Known problems in the QuarkXPress 4.0 and QuarkXPress Passport 4.0 Demo

- (Windows NT only) Printing from QuarkXPress 4.0 Demo under Windows NT 4.0 will not work if you are printing across a network. Printing to a local printer should function properly.
- Text in a polygon-shaped text box with left and right indents may flow outside of the bounding area of the text box when opened in QuarkXPress 4.0.
- When missing pictures are encountered in a new folder while updating pictures through the **Usage** dialog box, the updating process may stop. Manually clicking **Update** again will continue the process.
- QuarkXPress 3.3x documents containing an EPS in a picture box with a background of none will open in 4.0 with a Non-White Areas clipping path applied to the picture. This could cause the image to display and print differently than in 3.3x. To fix the problem, open the **Clipping** dialog box (**Item** menu), and change the clipping settings.
- Resizing an anchored line beyond the edge of the text box containing it will cause QuarkXPress to crash if **Live Refresh** is active in the **Application Preferences** (**Edit** menu).
- (QuarkXPress Passport only) Using "Erw. deutsche Silbentrennung" as the hyphenation method for German in the **Paragraph** tab of the **Document Preferences** dialog box (**Edit** menu) may cause some words containing multiple consonants to incorrectly hyphenate (for example,

schwimmen may hyphenate as schwim-mmen). Selecting the **Standard** hyphenation method will fix this problem.
