









## **Norton UnZip dialog box**

Norton UnZip can be used to expand files that were compressed using any of the following compression programs:

-  Space Wizard
-  PK Zip versions 1 and 2
-  WinZip
-  SEA ARC
-  LHA 2.1x.

 Norton Utilities Setup automatically associates .ZIP files with Norton UnZip if no other decompression software is detected on your computer. Subsequently, you can run Norton UnZip by simply double-clicking a .ZIP file.

This dialog box contains the following:

### **Expand: (zip,arc,...)**

If you double-clicked a compressed file, its name will appear here. You can specify a particular compressed file to expand by typing its path and name here.

### **Files To Extract:**

By default, Norton UnZip expands all the files in the archive. To select individual files to expand, type their names here, or click Contents to see a list of the files.

### **To:**

By default, Norton Unzip expands files to the current folder listed at the top of the dialog box. You can specify a different folder by typing it here.

### **Expand**

Click to expand the compressed files.

### **Contents**

Click to display the files that are contained in the compressed archive. You can select individual files from this list to expand. Hold down the Shift or Ctrl key while you click to select more than one file from the archive.

### **Only Extract If Newer**

Checking this option expands the file only if it is newer than a version of the file that might already exist in the specified folder.

### **Use Stored Folders**

If folder path information is stored with the compressed files, checking this option expands files into that folder structure, creating folders if necessary.

### **Remove Extracted Files**

Checking this option deletes the compressed files from the archive as soon as they are expanded.

Specify the name of the compressed file archive you want to expand. If you have double-clicked on a compressed file archive to open Norton UnZip, that file's name will appear here.

Specify the individual files you want to expand from the compressed file archive. The default is \*.\* (all files).

Click Contents to see a list of the compressed files, and select file names from the list.

Specify the folder to which you want the specified files expanded.

You must enter the correct password to expand any encrypted files from the archive.

If you choose Skip, this file will not be expanded.

If a version of a file already exists in the path you specified, expand the file only if it is newer.



If folder path information is stored in the compressed file archive, expand files into that folder structure, creating folders if necessary.

Delete each file from the compressed file archive as soon as it is unzipped.

Displays a list of files in the selected compressed file archive so you can choose the files you want to expand.

The files selected for deletion.

Edit this list directly or click Contents to select and deselect files from a list of files in the compressed file archive.



## **Browse compressed file contents**


Double click a file name in the File Contents list to select the file to extract from the compressed file archive.



You can select more than one file from the list by holding down the Shift or Ctrl key while you click with the mouse.

The list of compressed files in this archive.

Double click a file name to insert it into the Files to Extract box.

 You can select more than one file from the list by holding down the Shift or Ctrl key while you click with the mouse.

The name of the current folder.



Closes the dialog box without performing any action.

Saves all changes or performs the specified action, then closes the dialog box.

Opens the help file and displays information about this dialog box.
