Minimum System Requirements

IBM-compatible PC with CD-ROM Drive
Windows 95, Windows NT 3.51, or Windows 3.1x
8M RAM (12M recommended)
5M free hard disk space
256-color SVGA graphics
Web browser and Internet Connection

Running the Setup Program

Insert the CD-ROM into your drive and follow these steps to run the Setup program:

1. Windows 3.1 users, choose **File+Run** from the File Manager or Program Manager menu. Windows 95 users, click on the Start menu and choose **Run**.
2. Type **D:\SETUP** and press Enter. If your CD-ROM drive is not drive D, substitute the correct drive letter.
3. Click OK and the the setup program for the disc will start.
4. Follow the instruction in the setup program.

A Program group named *Web Page Contruction Kit 2* will be created. It contains icons for HTML Assistant Pro 2 SE and other important files.
