Congratulations! You have discovered one of the most simple and useful tools to improve your productivity in Windows.

Pointix Scroll is a utility that adds scrolling capabilities to your own mouse, through an exclusive patented method which uses mouse movements to control scrolling.

Pointix Scroll works with any kind of input device, including track-balls and touch-pads.

Advice for a Good Start

1. Use a high-quality mouse

Since Pointix relies on mouse movements, the more precise your mouse is, the better Pointix will work. If your mouse does not faithfully reproduce the movements of your hand, Pointix cannot interpret you correctly.

2. Keep your mouse in a good condition

For the same reasons explained above, it is important that your mouse be in a good condition. If your have a "ball" mouse (which is the most commonly used at present) try to keep the ball and mechanisms free from lint to avoid erratic operation.

3. Adjust the Sensitivity Parameters to your Style

Take a few seconds to "play" with the mouse observing the '<u>Preferences'</u> panel and adjust your parameters according to your style.

Theory of Operation

Pointix Scroll allows you to command scrolling from any cursor position, without using the <u>scroll-bars</u>. This feature is normally assigned to the right mouse button.

To use this method simply click and hold the scroll button (usually the right button) of your mouse and make a slight movement with the mouse to tell Pointix the <u>Scrolling Direction</u>.

Tips


- If you tap the scroll button, you get the normal function assigned to that button (for example, opening a pop-up menu), so you don't loose the right button functionality. (See: Scroll Time-out).
- The Pointix scrolling method allows you to control scrolling from anywhere on the screen, the only
 requirement being that, the cursor must be located somewhere *inside* the region you wish to scroll
 when you press the <u>Scroll Button</u>.
- If you press the <u>Scroll Button</u> while holding the 'Control' key, the scrolling is performed *on a page basis*, i.e. it is equivalent to pressing the scroll bars in the zones adjacent to the thumb box.
- The scrolling direction is set by the mouse movement even if you don't click the scroll button, so that you can set the direction in advance and start scrolling immediately.
- To drag objects with your right mouse button, just press and hold the "Shift" key and then drag the
 selected object. The "Shift" key temporarily disables the scrolling feature, enabling you to drag
 objects with your right mouse button.

Note: The scrolling feature is available in a large number of Windows applications. However, since the development of the Pointix scrolling method was after the definition of Windows 3.1 API, this feature may not be available in all applications. (Consult the information included with the program or contact Pointix Corporation to check in which applications this feature is available).

Preferences

This dialogue box allows you to modify the program's general settings.

Click on a specific area to obtain information about an item.



Scrolling Direction Monitor
Move the mouse to check if the
selected sensitivity is good for you.

Scrolling Direction Sensitivity
Modifies the scrolling direction sensitivity.
A high sensitivity means that small mouse movements are needed to change the scrolling direction.

Scroll Timeout

Modifies the Scroll Timeout setting. A shorter Scroll Timeout means that scrolling starts as soon as you press the scroll button.

Scroll Timeout Monitor

Use this monitor to check the Scroll Timeout settings.

Scroll Button

Assigns the scrolling function to a mouse button.

Scrollbars


These are the bars located to the right and below the window that are used to displace the point of view of a certain document or data collection.

Scroll Button

A mouse button used by Pointix to command scrolling. Normally, the right button is assigned.




Scrolling Direction
This is the direction in which a window moves with respect to the data it contains



How to Enable Pointix Scroll

Once you have installed Pointix Scroll in your computer, it will work in Trial Mode, which means that it will not work continuously but with periodic interruptions. You can switch from Trial Mode to Normal Mode at any time once you get your Personal Identification Number ("PIN") from Pointix Corporation.
