Running Ecopad32 From the Command Line

Ecopad32 offers you a number of options when run from the command line. The basic format is:

ecopad32 [options] [filename]

NOTE:

[filename] must be enclosed in quotes if it has spaces.

[options] can be one or more of the following in any order (separated by spaces). Options not specified will default to your last configuration settings.

Note that the /p2 (print two sided) option is no longer supported. Use /p /2 instead.



The settings you enter here are used only when printing booklets.

Gutter Margin

Ecopad32 uses a single measurement for both the left and right gutter margins.

Select inches or centimeters

How do I print my document as a booklet?

- 1.
- Select "Printing" from the "Options" menu Select "booklet" as the page layout option. 2.
- 3.
- To print the booklet on one side of the page only, select "Print" from the "File" menu.

 To print the booklet using both sides of the page, select "Print Odd/Even Pages" from the "File" menu.

Tips

- For best results, set the page orientation to "Landscape"
- You can set the gutter (inside) margins by clicking on the "Booklet" tab

What kinds of documents can I print with Ecopad32?

Ecopad32, like Windows Notepad, is a text editor. This means that Ecopad32 only understands plain text (ASCII) and Rich Text Format (rtf) documents. Other kinds of documents created with commercial word processors (like Microsoft Word) will not load or print correctly.

Note that when you open an RTF document into Ecopad32, Ecopad32 will extract only the text. Any formatting information (such as bold, italic) will be lost. Thus you should save the document with a ".txt" rather than an "rtf" extension, unless you're editing the rtf codes directly.

Tip

Anything that you can load into Windows Notepad, you can load into Ecopad32.

How large a document can I open?

Ecopad32 can open documents up to 32 megabytes in size.

How do I print with a very small (4 or 5 point) font?

In any Windows application (include Ecopad32), you can specify the point size of any True Type font by simply typing the desired point size in the "Size" textbox of the Choose Font Dialog box (the list box will only display point sizes as small as 8, so you have to type the size yourself if you want anything smaller).

Booklet Printing

Ecopad32 can now be used to print booklets!

- You can now select "**booklet**" in the page layout dialog box No other configuration is necessary Booklets can be printed single or double sided You can set the gutter (inside) margins

Configurable Tools

Ecopad32 now supports user configurable tools

- Add your favorite tools (executables) to the "tools" menu
 You can define the menu text for each tool
 You can define the command line arguments for each tool

Printing Configurations

Ecopad32 now lets you save your favorite printer configurations

- Save page layout, printing font, headers/footers, etc. using one name
 Quickly select saved configurations with the "Printing Configurations" combo box

More Tab Options

• You can set printing tabs in inches, centimeters, or characters in the printing font

Multiple Document Interface (MDI)

Ecopad32 now supports the MDI interface

• You can have as many open document windows as system memory allows

Line Numbers

You can now add line numbers to your printed documents

Finding characters or words

To find specific characters or words

- 1
- On the Search menu, click Find. In the Find What box, type the characters or words you want to find. 2
- Click Find Next.

To delete, cut, copy, and paste text

- To delete characters to the left of the insertion point, press the BACKSPACE key.
- To delete characters to the right of the insertion point, press the DELETE key.
- To delete words, select them, and then press the BACKSPACE or DELETE key.
- To cut text so you can move it to another location, select the text. Then, on the Edit menu, click Cut.
- To copy text so you can paste a copy of it in another location, select the text. Then, on the Edit menu, click Copy.
- To paste text you have cut or copied, place the insertion point where you want to paste the text. Then, on the Edit menu, click Paste.

To wrap text to the window size

On the Edit menu, click Word Wrap.

Note

• Wrapping text will also affect the way the text looks when printing

To insert the time and date in a document

- 1 Move the insertion point to where you want to add the time and date.
- 2 On the Insert menu, click Time/Date.

Tip

You can also insert the following document information (see the Edit menu):

- Filename
- File Time/Date
- Another text file

To keep a log by using Ecopad32

On the first line of an Ecopad32 document, type the following at the left margin, making sure you include the period:

.LOG

2 Save the document.

Note

Every time you open this document, Ecopad32 will append the current time and date, as specified by your computer's clock, to the end of it.

Booklet Printing

To print your document as a booklet using Ecopad32:

- Select "Printing" from the Options menu
- 2
- Click "Booklet" in the Page Layout listbox
 Click the "Landscape" button (recommended if your printer supports landscape printing) 3
- Click OK 4
- Select "Print" or "Print Two Sided" from the File menu 5

Notes

Booklets are always printed as two adjacent pages (equivalent to 1x2 page layout)

Save Printer Configuration Dialog

A printer configuration includes the following:

- Printing tabs
- Page layout, orientation
- Page drawing (lines, boxes)
- Header/Footer text, font, style
- Printing font
- Line number options

You can save all of this information under a single name, which can later be quickly selected for printing.

Name

Enter the name of the printer configuration. The name can contain up to 32 characters, including spaces

Time/Date Format Page (Printing Options Property Sheet)

Date

Select the date format.

Custom date format

If you select "custom" for **Date**, you can define your own date format here.

Time

Select the time format.

Reformat Text Dialog

Reformat

Click "All text" to reformat the entire document, or "Current selection only"

Convert DOS (OEM) text to Windows (ANSI text)

This option converts DOS text, which uses the OEM character set, to Windows text, which uses the ANSI character set. This option is useful if you're loading a file which was created with a DOS text editor.

Remove CR at the end of lines

Removes carriage returns at the end of each line.

Remove Page Breaks

Removes page breaks from the document.

Tip

After selecting OK, you can undo this formatting by selecting "Undo" from the Edit menu

General Printing Options Page

Printing Order

If you printer ejects pages in the correct order, select "First page to last". If you printer ejects pages in reverse order, select "Last page to first".

Use quick printing for toolbar buttons

If check, the "Print" toolbar buttons will not display the print dialog

Printing Tabs Property Page

You can set printing tabs at inches, centimeters, or characters in the current printing font.

Tip

If you are using a fixed width font, you can get good results with character tabs. If you're printing with a true type font, you'll get best results with inches or centimeters.

Advanced Printing Property Page

Compressed page margins in characters

These are special "gutter" margins which affect only the *inside margins* of compressed pages:





These margins are always measured in character widths (left, right) or heights (top, bottom) of the current printing font.

Header/Footer

You can set the number of lines (in the current printing font) between the header/footer and the start of the document text.

Display Options Property Page

Make the Mouse Pointer Invisible When Typing

When this option is selected, the mouse pointer will disappear when you start typing (making it easier to see the screen), and reappear when the mouse is moved.

Always on Top

Select this option to keep the Ecopad32 workspace on top of all other windows.

Open Document Windows Maximized

Select this option to open new document Windows maximized

Blue Background, White Text

Use blue background/white text for all document windows

Default to Word Wrap

When selected, new document windows will always open with word wrap checked (see the Edit menu)

Use Workspace Color

Use color for the workspace background. You can also select the color used by clicking "Customize..."

File Extensions Property Page

Current file extensions

Lists all of the file extensions which appear in the Files of type selection box in the file "Open" dialog.

Add

Add an extension

Delete

Delete an extension

Always default to *.*

When checked, the file "Open" dialog will default to "*.*" in the Files of type selection box.

General Options Property Page

Number of recent file to show on File menu

You can select between 0 and 8 files for Ecopad32 to remember on the recent file menu

Automatically convert RTF files when loading

If selected, Ecopad32 will extract the text automatically when loading a document with the extension ".rtf". If you want to edit the rtf codes directly, uncheck this option.

Automatically convert DOS text to Windows text

If selected, Ecopad32 will convert DOS text to Windows text automatically when loading a document. Useful only if you are working with a large number of DOS text documents.

Document Status Bar Property Page

The document status bar appears at the bottom of each document window you open. You can check zero or more of these options. The document status bar will disappear if all of the options are unchecked.

Tabs Property Page

The tabs you set hear apply only to the display of all documents (you set separate tabs for printing by selection Options/Printing... and clicking on the **Tabs** property page.)

Set tabs every **0** units to use the default value.

Add/Edit Tool Dialog

Menu Text

Displayed on the "Tools" menu

Command

The full path of the executable of the tool (for example, c:\winword.exe)

Arguments

Specifies additional arguments for the tool each time you start it. Several macros are also available:

Macro Name	Expands to			
\$(CurCol)	The current cursor column position within the active window.			
\$(CurDir)	The current working directory (defined as drive+path).			
\$(CurLine)	The current cursor line position within the active window.			
\$(FileExt)	The filename extension of the current source.			
\$(FileName) active.	The filename of the current source (defined as <i>filename</i>); blank if a nonsource window is			

\$(FilePath) The complete filename of the current source (defined as *drive+path+filename*); blank if a nonsource window is active.

Example:

To run Word for Windows with the current document, you would use **\$(FilePath)** as the argument.

Headers/Footers Dialog

View

Select either the header or footer

Text

The text of the header or footer. Click on the right arrow button to insert escapes (page number, etc.)

Lines

You can draw various lines above/below the header or footer.

Font

The font selected here will be used for both the header and the footer.

Page Layout Property Page

NOTE: The settings you enter here affect all documents.

Page Layout Select the printing compression

Page Orientation

Select Portrait or Landscape

Page Borders

Pages can optionally be separated by lines or boxes

Configuration

Select a printing configuration

Save As

Saves the current settings as a printing configuration

Delete

Deletes a printing configuration

Line Numbers Dialog

Add Line Numbers

Must be checked to enable line numbers

Stating At

Enter the starting line number. Must be larger than 0.

Count By

Displays the line number if it a multiple of this number. Usually this is set to 1.

Number of Digits

The width of the line number field in digits. For documents up to 99,999 lines, this should be set to 5. Increase this value to add more space to the line number field along the left margin.

Restart Each Page

Restart numbering each page at the value entered in **Starting At**

Show Leading Zero

For numbers smaller than the maximum number of digits, display leading zeros.

Example: line **5** would be displayed as **00005**.

Printing Margins Property Page

Set the printing margins here in inches or centimeters. These settings apply to all documents.

Fonts Dialog

Enter the fonts used for screen display and printing. These selections will apply to all documents opened in Ecopad32.

Tip

You can select a very small (less than 8 point) printing font by typing in the point size. The Windows printing dialogs do show fonts smaller than 8 points in the listbox, but a small point size can always be typed in directly.

Customize Tools Dialog

Ecopad32 allows you to add any number of tools (executable programs) to the tools menu.

Menu ItemsDisplays a list of the currently defined tools

Add

Adds a new tool

Edit the properties of a currently defined tool

Remove

Removes a tool

File Extension Dialog

The file extensions you enter here will appear in the "Show files of type" list box when you open a document in Ecopad32.

File Extension

Enter the three letter file extension. Do not include the period.

Description

Enter a description of the file extension

Two Sided Printing Options

Print Even Numbered Pages First

If your printer ejects pages face up, select this option.

Print Odd Numbered Pages First

If your printer ejects pages face down, select this option.

Side 1

Print Last Page To First

For most printers, regardless of page order, you should select this option

Print First Page To Last

Usually you should never have to select this option

Side 2

Print Last Page To First

If your printer ejects pages in the correct order, select this option

Print First Page To Last

If your printer ejects pages in reverse order, select this option
