Toolbar Help

The toolbar contains many different shortcuts to the programs that use the Internet. The initial programs that show on the Toolbar are ones from the TotalAccess package. The Toolbar is designed to contain any type of program shortcut on it. So if you wish to have icon for files, pictures, games, etc. you can easily [add them](#).



This icon launches the TotalAccess 2.0 program. From here you can create, retrieve, update an account. You may also adjust your phone number connections and bring up tutorials that provide a wealth of information.

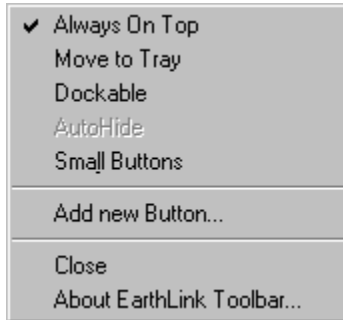

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EarthLink Toolbar

Menu Help

Upon right clicking on the EarthLink Network logo you will be presented with the following menu. From here you can change the various settings of the Toolbar and make it look the way you want it to. The Toolbar is able to attach itself to the sides of your screen and even hide itself when not in use. Click on the menu below to see what each option does.



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Always on Top

Keeps the Toolbar on top of all windows allowing it not to be hidden by another window.

This is very helpful if you use your tool bar a lot and don't want it to be hidden by another program.

Move to Tray

Moves the Toolbar to the system tray (the area beside the time on your taskbar).
Click the icon in the tray to restore the Toolbar back to its last position.

Dockable

Allows the Toolbar to attach itself to the edge of the screen that it was dragged to.

When the Toolbar is in its dockable mode it behaves just like Windows Taskbar. You can drag it from one side of the screen to the other and it will reattach. You can even have it retract and hide itself from view when not in use and extend when you move your mouse back to it by using the AutoHide feature.

AutoHide

This allows the toolbar to hide itself when it is not being used.

This function is only available when Docking is turned on and the Toolbar has attached itself to an edge of the screen.

Small Buttons

Toggle between large icons or small icons for the programs on the Toolbar.

Add new button

Add a program shortcut to the Toolbar.

Close

Adding a new icon

As you start to use your EarthLink Toolbar more and more you will find out what a handy tool it is in regards to the Internet and Windows in general. One nice feature of the Toolbar is the ability to add more icons to it. Adding shortcuts will launch your most used programs, games, you name it.

Step 1

Right click on the EarthLink Network logo.

Step 2

Select **Add new button** from the list.

Step 3

You will then be presented with a standard Windows open menu. From here find the file you wish to add to the Toolbar, highlight it and click **open** and your new shortcut will add itself to the Toolbar.

Note: The Toolbar supports drag and drop so you can drag your favorite program to the Toolbar and it will create a shortcut to it for you.

If you wish to remove an icon the step are just as easy.

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Removing an icon

There may come a time when you need to remove an icon from the EarthLink Toolbar.

Step 1

Right click on the icon that you wish to remove.

Step 2

Click the **remove** button and the icon will be removed.
